The core of the Holiness Gospel is focused on the five-fold gospel consisting of Regeneration, Sanctification, Divine Healing, Resurrection, and Second Coming of the Lord. The Resurrection indicates that the Lord overcame death, resurrected, and became the Savior of all men. Here the term 'resurrection' doesn't just mean that a dead man is revived, but also it means the revived man gains perfect life and lives forever without seeing death.

As described in the Acts of Apostles, the disciples of Jesus Christ witnessed the resurrected Lord Jesus in person and came to be sure about their resurrection that would happen at the end time. With the assurance, they could lead a totally transformed life. Practically all of them had such firm faith in the resurrection that they were able to accept martyrdom while preaching the gospel.

On March 31, 2013, it was Easter Sunday, the time when Christians commemorate Jesus Christ's resurrection. In the Sunday Morning Service, Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee delivered the message entitled "Resurrection" based on Acts 1:11. He said every man has no choice but to die, but through the Lord's crucifixion and resurrection the way of eternal life was opened. He added that we can walk the way by being forgiven of sins and becoming God's child.

In the Sunday Evening Service, he preached with the title of "Grace Given to Us" taken from John 6:53-55. He emphasized that we should recover the image of God's child that God really wants by eating the flesh of the Son of Man and drinking His blood, namely, knowing and practicing the Word of God. After the message, Holy Communion was held in the main sanctuary, the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th sanctuaries and the members in other local sanctuaries and branch churches also joined the ceremony via GCN TV simultaneously. Catechism Ceremony and Baptism Ceremony were held on March 17, 2013 and on March 24, 2013 respectively.

Commemorating Easter Sunday, Women's Mission gave Easter eggs to the church members, government offices, schools, and offices around the church. In doing so, they delivered the love of the Lord who overcame death and resurrected. The church members had been preparing for the Easter Sunday by looking back upon their Christian life, repenting, and giving thanks and with prayer and fasting. With the day as the starting point, they came to be able to increase their faith more quickly. In fervent prayer, they have imprinted the love of the Lord on the cross and the glory of the resurrection in their hearts. They are now running to experience the resurrection.

#### Goodness (8)

### Naaman's Goodness

"And there were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian" (Luke 4:27).

Naaman was a captain of the army of the king of Aram, a country that was adjacent to Israel. He was a valiant warrior, but he was a leper as written in 2 Kings 5:1. In those days, leprosy was an incurable disease so he couldn't be free from it even with good medicine or outstanding medical treatment of the time. He wasn't healed even when he relied on the god he served. But he received healing by the power of God after meeting Elisha the prophet of Israel.

The Bible tells us that not all men have been able to receive blessing although they were with prophets who performed great power and they were with Jesus the Son of God. Only the ones who sought the truth with goodness like the deer pants for the brook's water, like Namaan, can meet the living God and receive blessing.

So, Luke 4:27 reads, "And there were many lepers in Israel in the time of Elisha the prophet; and none of them was cleansed, but only Naaman the Syrian." By seeing the deeds of Naaman we can understand the keys to receiving the answers from God. Then, what aspects of Naaman were deemed as goodness?

#### 1. Listening to the good news with humbleness

In the house of Naaman there was a young maidservant who had been taken captive from Israel. One day, she said to her mistress, "I wish that my master were with the prophet who is in Samaria! Then he would cure him of his leprosy."

These words of hers were told to Naaman, and he did not reject her words at that time. Although he had a very high position next to the king, he was so humble that he would not even neglect the word of a lowly maidservant.

The words of the maidservant was the news of goodness. If we listen attentively to the good news with humbleness no matter whoever might preach it, God deems our hearts to be good. If Naaman had been wicked and stubborn, he would have neglected her words saying, "You are only a maidservant, why do you interfere?"

Today many people will not listen when we evangelize them saying, "God is alive. He can answer anything you desire if you come to Him with faith." Their reaction tells us the extent that they are good. There are many who do not want to hear what preachers say though it is heard. As they come to hold higher positions and have greater possessions, they will not listen to the preachers and they tend to rely on the world more and more.

#### 2. Showing the evidence of faith with deeds after listening to the good news

When he heard about the prophet of Israel from the maidservant, he didn't send his servants to bring the

prophet to him and he didn't send a letter asking the prophet to pray for him. He himself went to the prophet.

2 Kings 5:5 says, "[Naaman] departed and took with him ten talents of silver and six thousand shekels of gold and ten changes of clothes." Naaman showed his earnest desire to be healed with offerings he had prepared with sincerity.

Naaman did not expect that he would reap what he had not sown. So, when he went to the prophet of God, he did not expect more than what he had sown. Instead, he prepared offerings with sincerity and earnest hope for his healing.

In the end, Namaan came to Elisha, though he was sick, with offerings he had prepared. But Elisha didn't personally come before Namaan, but he just sent a messenger to him, saying, "Go and wash in the Jordan seven times, and your flesh will be restored to you and you will be clean." Naaman was furious and said, "Behold, I thought, 'He will surely come out to me and stand and call on the name of the LORD his God, and wave his hand over the place and cure the leper."

When Elisha's servant told him to go wash himself seven times in the Jordan to be healed, in Namaan's own mind and by his own thoughts he could not believe what the servant had said. He has gone to Elisha with faith, but because Naaman had fleshly limitations, he could not believe and accept the words of the prophet, and instead he felt as if he had been mistreated. He was just about to return to his own country.

But, the following deeds of his tell us how good and humble he was. His servants said to him in 2 Kings 5:13, "My father, had the prophet told you to do some great thing, would you not have done it? How much more then, when he says to you, 'Wash, and be clean'?" The fact that the servants called him 'My father' and they could give advice to their master shows how good and humble he was

He did not neglect the words of his servants but listened to them. He was so broadminded that he could accept whatever was right and good. That's

why his servants could advise him with love. Naaman eventually turned his thinking around and he obeyed the advice his servants offered him. He dipped himself in the Jordan River seven times as instructed by the prophet Elisha.

The number "7" spiritually refers to the perfection. The water of the Jordan symbolizes the Word of God. So, his dipping himself in the Jordan seven times meant he fully obeyed the Word of God. He did not give up although he was not healed the third or fourth time. He fully obeyed God's command and dipped himself in the river seven times, in that way he fully experienced the work of God.

He followed the good will of God and obeyed the Word to the very last even though it was not consistent with his own thoughts. When Naaman believed the word of the prophet and fully obeyed it, God accepted it joyfully and healed him of his leprosy as recorded in 2 Kings 5:14. In other words, when we trust men of God, God regards it as trust in Him and as goodness, as recorded in 2 Chronicles 20:20.

#### 3. To repay the grace he received unchangingly and without forsaking it

Luke chapter 17 describes that Jesus healed ten leprous men but only one of them came to Him and gave thanks. Then, Jesus said in Luke 17:17, "Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine—where are they?"

Today when many people pray to God that He might heal them or give them the desires of their heart, they confess they will be faithful to the point of death after healing or vow something to receive God's answer. But in many cases they forget their confession after being healed. But Namaan didn't forsake the grace. 2 Kings 5:15 reads, "When he returned to the man of God with all his company, and came and stood before him, he said, 'Behold now, I know that there is no God in all the earth, but in Israel; so please take a present from your servant now.""

After he was healed, he didn't just leave for his country. He returned to Elisha with all his company and expressed his thanks. He also made a remark of determination that he would only acknowledge and serve God. (2 Kings 5:17)

Just as said above, God chose Namaan and received glory through him though he was a Gentile since he had a good inner heart that gave thanks for God's grace and would never betray God whom he met.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the greatness of your blessing and the speed of answers are different according to how much goodness you have cultivated in your heart. I pray in the name of the Lord that you will have the heart of goodness like that of Namaan and manifest the goodness in perfect deeds. I hope by doing so you will become the source of joy and receive answer to your heart's desire.

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

#### Subdue the earth and rule over everything on it

God the Creator formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being. God planted a garden toward the east, in Eden; and there He placed the man whom He had formed and blessed him to enjoy the authority as God's child. God taught everything to the man and allowed him to subdue and rule over everything on the Earth as well as to cultivate and keep the Garden of Eden.

Genesis 1:28 records how much blessing God gave to Adam the first man He created. The first blessing that God gave to Adam was to 'be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth.' Along with Eve, whom God gave to Adam as his wife, Adam became fruitful, multiplied, and filled the 'earth' with his children in the Garden of Eden.

The second blessing that God gave to Adam was to 'subdue the earth.' God gave Adam the Garden of Eden and the Earth as an inheritance and told him to 'rule over and keep' them. The third blessing that God gave to Adam was to 'rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over every living thing that moves on the earth.' God gave Adam wisdom and understanding to make it possible, and blessed him to be able to rule over the animals by being in communion with them.

By the way, there was another reason why God allowed Adam to subdue the earth and to rule over everything. This is because in the second heaven, to which the Garden of Eden belongs, there is an area where the spirits of the darkness dwell as well.

In the second heaven, there is the Garden of Eden which belongs to the domain of light and there is also the domain of darkness. They are adjacent to each other. God separated the light from the darkness after saying, "Let there be light" on the first day of the six-day creation for human cultivation. Then, as it was the first night, God released evil spirits from the

Abyss. And on the second day, God gave them a place where they could dwell in the east of the Garden of Eden.

On the sixth day, God formed man and gave him the authority to subdue and rule over the earth and all things in it. God wanted him to protect the Garden of Eden and the Earth from evil spirits and blessed him to live the life worthy to be deemed God's child.

#### With the truth, subdue your heart which is the spiritual field

As recorded in Genesis 2:16-17, God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely; but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die." That is, eating from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil leads to death because the tree symbolizes God's sovereignty.

When the first man Adam obeyed the Word of God, he could subdue the earth and rule over all things on it. But everything changed after he ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. He was sent out from the Garden of Eden because he failed to watch over his heart and disobeyed. In the end, he came to eat from the ground only in toil because the ground of the earth was cursed due to his sin. He also eventually was faced with death just as it had been spoken that 'the wages of sin is death.'

Just as written in Matthew chapter13, the ground and the field here stand for the heart of men who are formed of the dust from the ground. In other words, it indicates that whoever conquers his heart, which is spiritual land, and rules over it in accordance with the Word of God can recover the authority and power which Adam once possessed. Thus, when you cultivate the heart field into fertile land, it is the same as subduing spiritual land.

To the same extent that you don't cultivate the heart-field into fertile land, you can't subdue your

own heart. As long as you have fleshly attributes left in your heart, you cannot be said to have conquered your heart completely. This is because your heart is changeable if fleshly attributes still remain in you.

When we subdue our hearts completely, we can overcome the world that is full of sin and evil and keep our hearts from the worldly things. But if you don't you will be rather subdued by the worldly things when temptations or hardship come to you. Here, you can check how much you conquer your heart by seeing if you practice what you plan to do. To conquer it perfectly, you need to throw away 'rocks' in your heart and also root out the 'thorns' in it. Then, God's blessing will follow you.

#### Subdue your heart by filling it with love

After subduing our heart, what should we control and rule over, and how? For example, if you have hatred in your heart, it is subduing your heart to pull it out. And when you put love in your heart, it is to control your heart. If you completely fill your heart with love it is to rule over your heart. If you reach this level, you will have no fleshly thought, hear the voice of the Spirit, and receive His guidance.

As read in Philippians 2:13, "For it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure," God is at work in us and leads us to achieve His will. The Spirit who searches all things, even the depths of God, lets us hear His voice, and guides us to the prosperous way.

If anyone can subdue his heart, it means he has cast away all untruthful things, so he can watch over his heart. In addition, if you control and rule over your heart with generous virtue and love, the evil one cannot touch you and people will obey you from the bottom of their hearts. People around you will praise you. We hope you will subdue, control, and rule over your heart and enjoy authority and blessing of God's child.


