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Pastors' Seminars and Miracle Healing Crusades in Pakistan

Full of the Spirit's works like a violent rushing wind and powerful messages



In Pastors' Seminars and Miracle Healing Crusades, Pastor Taesik Gil is preaching the love of Jesus Christ and confirming the living God with signs. Pakistan, where over 97% of its population is Muslim! On the spiritually barren land, the 'flower' of the holiness gospel blossomed in the earnest love of God for souls there.

For the last 11 years, Pastor Taesik Gil ministering to Daejeon Manmin Church has led seminars and healing crusades in many areas in Pakistan including Islamabad, the capital city, with the handkerchief of power on which Dr. Jaerock Lee had prayed (Ref: Acts 19:11-12). From April 5 to 15, 2013, he went on another mission trip to Pakistan.

Pastor Gil preached in five Pastors' Seminars and Miracle Healing Crusades in Pakistan's second city Lahore, and in Sheikhpura, Multan, and Karachi. He also met twice with the bishops. During the mission trip, approximately 200 pastors have had their churches register as Manmin's branch and associative churches and many healing works unfolded, which planted great faith in attendees.

In the Lahore Crusade, there were around 8,000 people in attendance and Pastor Gil preached about "Holy Spirit"

taken from Acts 2:1-4. He also delivered the message on "God the Healer" based on Exodus 15:26 at the Sheikhpura Crusade, Multan Crusade, and Karachi Crusade, which were attended by approximately 6,000 people, 3,000, and 450 respectively.

After the messages, Pastor Gil prayed for the sick with the handkerchief of power and many in attendance were set free from diseases, pains, and infirmities.

Shraz, aged 11, had bad vision and couldn't see well, but came to see well. Wumal Ali, aged 8, had been mute since he was three, but began to speak. Shakina, age 45, who had walked relying on a cane after surgery on a hip joint, was able to walk without it. Nashin, aged 35, stood up from a wheelchair and was able to walk.

Youshaf Masik, aged 50, was healed of paralysis of right shoulder and now he can move the right arm and shoulder without any trouble. Sahril, aged 7, was healed of congenital asthma. Avid, aged 25, received the prayer on behalf of his brother who was suffering from stomachaches and he confirmed the brother had been cured and rejoiced.

In addition, Bushra, aged 40, was healed of 5-year-old brain tumor and

Shaniz, aged 23, received the blessing of conception through the prayer of Dr. Jaerock Lee on Isaac TV (President Pastor Anwar Fazal).

Isaac TV broadcasts Dr. Lee's messages in English and Urdu for six hours a day in Pakistan and throughout the whole Middle East.

In Lahore Pastors' Seminar, Pastor Gil delivered the message on 'God the Creator' and 'The Secret Hidden before the Ages'. In the Sheikhpura, Multan, and Karachi Pastors' Seminars, he preached about 'God Who Cultivates Humans' and 'The Reason Why God Placed the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil'.

He also visited the regular meeting of United Bishop Council Pakistan. He introduced the ministry of Manmin and preached a message from Romans 5:8 entitled "Why Is Jesus Christ Our Only Savior?" Then, he met with bishops in Lahore and explained about Manmin's vision for the Pakistani ministry.

The pastors in the seminars were amazed saying, "I have never heard of this kind of spiritual message." They

showed interest in Manmin's vision for the world mission and hope to join it.

Pastor Samuel said in gratefulness, "I have taught seminary students the Bible as an instructor, but I came to reach a new level of knowledge today. It will be great help to teaching my students." Pastor Asif Aslam stated, "What I knew was just nothing. With the holiness gospel, God renewed us. I am so grateful for allowing us to listen to such a message of blessings."

Moses' Goodness (2)

“Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth... My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house.” (Numbers 12:3, 7 KJV).

When he was a prince of Egypt, Moses always felt distressed due to his people in sufferings. In the meantime, he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. Out of resentment he struck down the Egyptian.

The incident became known and Moses had to flee from Egypt. It was when he was 40 years old. From then on, he tended the flock as a shepherd in the wilderness of Midian for 40 years.

In those days, shepherding was one of the lowliest of occupations in the sight of the Egyptians. Tending the flock that was deemed menial, Moses utterly demolished his sense of self-confidence and self-righteousness as a prince of Egypt. Right then, God called Moses as a leader of the Israelites' Exodus from Egypt.

What kind of goodness allowed Moses to guide the Israelites to the promised land, Canaan?

1. Moses was very meek, more than any man who was on the face of the earth

As written in Numbers 12:3 KJV, “Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth,” Moses was gentle enough to be deemed the meekest man on the face of the earth in his times.

Spiritual gentleness that is indicated in the Word of God refers to a tender and kind heart accompanied with virtuous deeds. This gentleness is not only a tender and comfortable heart that is soft like cotton but also generous virtue that is accompanied with proper words and decorum and dignity to lead people. A man of gentleness can have peace with everybody.

It was Moses who achieved this heart. When the Israelites came out of Egypt, there were about six hundred thousand men, but including women and children there was a total of about two million people who followed Moses. Moses suffered many hardships while he led such a great multitude of people through the tough desert travel for 40 years.

When Moses obeyed with faith, the Red Sea was parted and they walked across it as though they were on the dry land. But, as they walked through the desert three days later, they found no water at all and began to complain about Moses. Moses tolerated them, and he cried out to God for them and God performed a miracle through him by changing the bitter water of Marah into sweet water to drink.

It was not long before they began to complain again because there was no food for them to eat. (Exodus 16:3) For these ungrateful people, Moses prayed again to God to fulfill their petition. Through his prayer, God provided them with manna and quails.

When they set out on their journey from the Wilderness of Sin, and camped in Rephidim, there was no water for them to drink. Again, they quarreled with Moses and were even about to stone him. They said, “Why, now, have you brought us up from Egypt,

to kill us and our children and our livestock with thirst?”

Moses cried out in prayer to God for them again. He struck the rock with his staff before the eyes of elders of the people, and then water came out of it. In that way, the Israelites complained and grumbled at even small things and they did not have true faith though Moses had guided them with the great power of God.

Moreover, they committed a great sin before God. While Moses received the Ten Commandments from God on Mount Sinai, they molded a golden calf and worshipped it. God became furious and said to Moses, “I have seen this people, and behold, they are an obstinate people. Now then let Me alone, that My anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them; and I will make of you a great nation.”

Moses earnestly prayed that God would turn from His burning anger and change His mind about doing harm to His people as written in Exodus 32:11-13. By his prayer, God turned His will about and did not pour out His wrath upon them.

When Moses came down from the mountain, he saw them committing the great sin. In Exodus 32:31-32 it says that he knelt down before God and prayed, “Alas, this people has committed a great sin, and they have made a god of gold for themselves. But now, if You will, forgive their sin—and if not, please blot me out from Your book which You have written!”

The people committed such a great sin before God, but still Moses could not see the nation being destroyed. So, he asked God to forgive them with his life as collateral. It showed that Moses accomplished the highest level of goodness in which he could give his life to his enemy and fully embraced the people of Israel with that perfect goodness. That's why God the Father said he was gentler than anyone else on the earth.

2. Moses was faithful in all God's household

‘Being faithful’ is that you have fully carried out the

God-given duties and accomplished more than your personal duties require. ‘Being faithful in all God's house’ here means to be faithful in every kind of work at home, at school, and at workplace or business.

To be faithful to all God's house, you must be able to sacrifice yourself without sparing your heart, your sincerity and your time. Hebrews 3:5 says, “Now Moses was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken later.”

His task, commissioned by God, was to lead the Israelites out of Egypt into the land of Canaan. In many hardships, Moses never shirked his responsibility nor abandoned his task at all. He passed through every kind of hardship by faith.

He embraced the people of Israel with the heart of a father and painstakingly tried to make them the people God wanted.

But because their faith was so weak that was far from the standard God wanted, he always had to mourn and petition to God for them. He never rested, even for a moment from the day he led them out of Egypt until the day when he ended his life on the earth. He shed immeasurable tears for them, and his tearful prayers and mourning petitions for them are beyond description.

Because Moses had this kind of heart, God trusted Moses too. God performed great works of power through him. God even spoke to Moses face to face as if a man speaks to his friend, and he enjoyed deep fellowship with God as written in Numbers 12:8. Then, was Moses courageous and pompous before God because he was fully faithful to all God's house? No, he never was.

Among the first generation of the Israelites who were over 20 years old and escaped from Egypt, only two people entered the land of Canaan. It was the second generation who conquered the promised land. The second generation of the Israelites could conquer it because Moses led and taught them in faith. Nonetheless, he was always sorry before God for not reaping much more fruit.

Have you ever thought your duty was too heavy and laborious and wanted to abandon it and rest? We have to be reminded of the heart of Moses who, from the moment he led the people out of Egypt until the moment he was lifted up into Heaven by God, had never rested peacefully because of worries about the people. I hope you will remember the heart of Moses who had been faithful in all God's house, but he was still sorry before God because he did not reap more fruit, and continually push yourselves to continue your race.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I pray in the name of the Lord that you will bear abundant fruit by achieving the gentleness of Moses and being faithful in all God's household everywhere you go, at home, school, workplace, and business.

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Casting off Sloth and Laziness that Disrupt Spiritual Growth

“Stop resorting to excuses”

Proverbs 22:13 reads, “The sluggard says, ‘There is a lion outside; I will be killed in the streets!’” As recorded, sluggards usually resort to excuses for their sloth and laziness. In this way there are Christians who do not obey the Word of God by offering excuse after excuse.

Hearing that they have to evangelize people, they might say, “I do not know how to do it,” “I am too shy to do it,” or “I don’t know anybody who I can lead to church”. If asked to take charge of a God-given duty and work faithfully, they make the excuse of lacking the ability. With just the desire to obey, you can do it. If you do not know how to do whatever it is, you can ask others how to do it. If you think you are not wise enough or not capable of fulfilling the work, you can receive wisdom and strength from God by asking! But many people just offer excuses without obeying. They just ascribe their rejection to the environment or pass responsibility off to other people. They may become distressed or lose heart. They should not complain, express discontent or even expect others to help them. They must just do their best to obey.

Proverbs 20:4 reads, “The sluggard does not plow after the autumn, so he begs during the harvest and has nothing.” As said, a lazy man cannot help but be hungry both in fleshly sense and spiritual sense. He will ‘hunger’ at the time of the last judgment if he is lazy in cultivating his heart. In other words, he will be uncertain about salvation as well as have no reward in Heaven. Thus, we need to cultivate our heart-field diligently by praying fervently and turning it into good soil. By doing so, we will be able to meet the Lord joyfully when He comes again to take us home.

If it seems just too difficult to cast away every form of evil, what do we have to do? You should not attribute your laziness to your family background or on your social, economic or other environmental situation. You shouldn’t feel distressed, but instead, you just have to admit your shortcomings and pray to cast them away starting from something small. Then, we can move on to achieve rapid spiritual growth.

Let’s suppose a situation of Satan posing a question to subordinates and promises to award a prize to one who gives the correct answer. The question is as follows: “How can we lead many Christians to Hell?”

A subordinate named ‘Speculation’ says, “It is possible if we persuade them saying there is no God based on speculation.” Another subordinate ‘Doubt’ suggests, “If we show the righteous in sufferings and the unrighteous are well-off, Christians will leave their faith behind.”

Now the other subordinate ‘Sloth’ says, “Sloth is the simplest way to make Christians go to Hell. Just say, ‘Do not make haste. You do not have to hurry up.’”

Whose idea do you think is chosen?

A sluggard expects a better result than what he has sown. He wants it without toil. Though he desires to get things, he wants to get them for nothing without having to work and though he has desires, he strays from the right path, tries tricks, or just hopes for luck.

Proverbs 26:15 says, “The sluggard buries his hand in the dish; he is weary of bringing it to his mouth again.” A sluggard does not eat although there is food in front of him.

A spiritual sluggard has lukewarm faith since he does not act in the Word of God although he listens to it.

By delving into the two characteristics of sloth, let’s stop being lazy and change our hearts diligently with the Word of God which is the truth.

“Stop being content with the status quo”

Proverbs 26:14 says, “As the door turns on its hinges, so does the sluggard on his bed.” Just as the door fixed on its hinges moves in its limit, the sluggard who seeks comfort idly tosses and turns on his bed. A lazy man does only what he has done before in an undemanding way. He lives a life without laying aside the former manner of unambitiousness and without trying to push ahead for a better life.

Matthew 11:12 reads, “From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and violent men take it by force.” To take a better dwelling place in Heaven, we must take it by force. If you stop trying to take it by force at some point your faith cannot continue to grow up. With force you have to demolish self-righteousness, self-frameworks, all speculations, and fleshly thoughts by means of the Word of God which is the truth. Some people, however, just hold what currently seems good to them and what is beneficial for them, so they cannot experience spiritual growth.

A spiritually lazy man passes judgment and condemnation on others in his self-righteousness and self-frame work that he has made with what he has learned. He gives hard times to others. He also has hard time or he shrinks away when others try to teach him and give him advice. Even if he has been a Christian for a long time, if he is content with the status quo without any development, he will become like stagnant water that is bound to corrupt.

Such people are not being content in humbleness, but in sloth. So, it causes many kinds of problems as the time passes. We are supposed to move forward to a better dwelling place in the eternal Heaven, but if you are stuck in the middle without spiritual growth, it indicates backsliding in faith.

In order to grow up in spirit, we must not be content with the abilities that we have acquired through experience and repeated deeds during the course of our Christian lives. Only when you fulfill your duty together with continuous circumcision of the heart can you demonstrate spiritual authority and perform the manifestation of miracles. Therefore, I hope that you will bear abundant fruit by stopping being lazy! Cultivate your heart and achieve a good and beautiful heart.

In early 2004, I was guided by my wife Deaconess Gyeyoung Ahn to Daejeon Manmin Church ministered to by Pastor Taesik Gil. At that time we hadn't got married yet and I lived in Seongnam, Gyeonggi Province where I worked. On Sundays, I went all the way to Daejeon to attend church.

After around a year, a change was brought to my life as a Christian. I found it interesting and was absorbed in getting a better understanding of the heart of God and His will while listening to Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee's sermons in the Manmin Central Church's worship services broadcast simultaneously via GCN TV.

One of lectures on Genesis explained about dinosaurs. I felt as though the sermon was a 3D movie. The sermon

In October, 2005, I received Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer to get a job. In early December at just the right time, the

Korea Institute of Energy Research located in Daejeon posted a job opening on the internet. I applied to the department of LED lighting and God answered my heart's desire. In May 2009 my wife and I got married after seven-year relationship and made a happy family.

In 2002, I earned my Masters at Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology, but I felt the need to get my Ph. D while working as a researcher. So, in autumn, 2009, I entered New Material Engineering Department of Chungnam National University. In February 2012, I was awarded a doctoral degree of engineering through research in the photovoltaic module that is used for developing solar energy.

Generally, it takes much time both to work and to earn a doctoral degree. But I finished the course in seven semesters. Many graduate students suffer from mental stress for a half year or a year when they have to complete their dissertation. So, my coworkers advised me to gird up my loins to study and earn the degree. However, I was able to get the degree without any difficulty.

It was all because of God's grace. God led me in the most prosperous ways while I took classes, did my assignments, and took tests. I prayed in Daniel Prayer Meeting every night. I read the Bible, and memorized the verse every day. I was not lazy in arming myself with the Word of God. I also fulfilled my God-given duties as a choir member, a Children's Sunday School teacher, a member of New Comers Management, and in the Education Department of Men's Mission. My wife said I did not seem to be in the doctoral program.

God blessed me to finish the course in a short period of time and He blessed me with a salary increase. Also, I became well-known in the field of the solar light power, and I have given lectures in companies beginning in 2011. I give all thanks and glory to God who led me to the blessed way both in spirit and body.

I am a junior in the Department of Humanities at the University of Delhi. Before I came to Delhi Manmin Church, ministered to by Pastor John Kim, I had attended church but I had no change in my life. I sometimes preached the gospel and prayed but I became weary with no hope.

At that time, I had suffered for six months from irregular menstruation due to polycystic ovary syndrome. The principal features are anovulation, resulting in irregular menstruation, amenorrhea, and ovulation-related infertility. I was in pain due to a sleep disorder, headaches, and pains in both hands and feet which were caused by the surgery for spondylitis I had had when I was 14. I had prayed for the disease every morning, but there was no way for me to overcome it. I forgot to smile and became very nervous, so I often argued with others and burst out in anger. Because of the pain I got weary and wanted to die.

One day, I heard about Dr. Jaerock Lee's messages and his powerful works from Brother Lavi Agugin who is an acquaintance of mine. He came to know about Dr. Lee reading the book *Hell* that his friend had given to him. He had received a lot of grace from the book and logged on to Manmin Central Church's website at www.manmin.org. His life as a Christian was renewed as he listened to Dr. Lee's messages on the website and he went to the Manmin Church in Delhi. 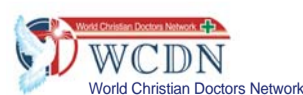
I give my heartfelt thanks to God who answered my prayer and Dr. Lee who prayed for me.



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
