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Pastors' Seminars and Handkerchief Healing Meetings in Nepal, India, and Hong Kong



From November 8 to 21, 2016, Rev. Heesun Lee, Manmin World Guidance Pastor (Photo 1) held pastors' seminars and handkerchief healing meetings in Nepal, India, and Hong Kong. She preached the holiness gospel and prayed with the handkerchief of power.

Katmandu, Nepal: Awakening of Pastors and Healing of Leprosy

On November 10, Rev. Lee had a meeting with the members of Nepal Manmin Church in the morning, and led a Pastors' and Workers' Seminar. The seminar was attended by more than 750 (Photo 2). People from Dubai and Bahrain as well as many areas of Nepal attended with longing.

On the morning of November 11th at Nepal Manmin Church they held the 11th Anniversary Service and Celebration Event. Around 600 people attended. Rev. Lee preached the message under the title of 'Change' taken from Philippians 2:17-18.

In the afternoon, Rev. Lee prayed

with the handkerchief on which Dr. Jaerock Lee had prayed (Acts 19:11-12). After she prayed (Photo 7) many people testified to their healing. Many people were healed of their diseases including asthma, itchiness, thyroid disease, and urinary incontinence. Brother Home Bahadul Rai (Photo 8) regained the ability to hear through the ear that had been deaf for three years and his bent back was straightened. Brother Jei Ram Buzel was healed of leprosy (his story on page 4).

Delhi, Northern India: Healing of Hearing Impairment and Spaceand-Time-Transcending Healing of Chikungunya

On November 13, Delhi Manmin Church had its Fourth Anniversary Service (Photos 3 and 4) with approximately 350 people in attendance.

Rev. Lee preached the message "Fruit" based on 1 John 3:18, and prayed with the handkerchief. Brother Papu was healed of the after-effects of ocular implants. Sister Rohan's mother, who was suffering from chikungunya virus at home, was healed transcending space and time (Photo 9).

Brother Umeshi (Photo 10) was deaf but came to hear through Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer in Manmin Summer Retreat 2016. He guided deaf people to the meeting and four of them came to hear. Many other people were healed of their poor eyesight, diabetes, and dermatitis.

Chennai, Southern India and Hong Kong: Healing of Deafness and Blindness

On November 16, Rev. Lee met with the members of Chennai Manmin Church. The church had its 12th Anniversary Service with approximately 500 people in attendance (Photos 5 and 6) and she conducted a Handkerchief Healing Meeting. She delivered a message on "Love" (John 15:7-9) and prayed with the handkerchief.

Brother Jaswansing who came back from the threshold of death due to heart attack through Dr. Lee's prayer in August 2016 was healed of insomnia and pain in shoulders (Photo 11).

Brother Rajendran (Photo 12) came to hear through both of his ears and speak. Sister Rebecca was healed of diabetes and pains over her whole body caused by its complications, and Brother Reuben was healed of a fracture of his leg. In addition to them, many others were healed of asthma and diseases caused by stroke, and some were set free from demons and received many kinds of blessings such as financial blessing and promotion in workplace.

On November 20, Thanksgiving Sunday Service and Holy Communion were held in Hong Kong, and in the following handkerchief healing meeting many people were healed of various diseases including healing of blindness.

"I love those who love me; and those who diligently seek me will find me" (Proverbs 8:17).

With unchanging and eternal love, God loves His children in endurance, patience, hope, and waiting. In this message I'd like to delve into the people who love God in three aspects: faithfulness, sanctification and love for the souls.

Firstly, those who love God are faithful.

1 Corinthians 4:2 says, "Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful" (NKJV). To accomplish the kingdom of God, there must be dedication of the workers. For this reason, God is searching throughout the whole earth to find those who will fulfill His plan understanding His heart. Also, if any worker fulfills the desires of the Father through faithful work, He will reward them with glory and blessings.

But John 6:63 first part says, "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing." So, our faithfulness must not be a fleshly one but a spiritual one. In order to have spiritual faithfulness we must first circumcise our hearts by struggling against sins to the point of shedding blood. If you are leaders of the church and still disgrace God or make others stumble due to your temper, hardfeelings, arrogance, and greed, then how can you be recognized as being really faithful?

"Those Who Love Me"

Also, those who are spiritually faithful perform their duties for the Lord and the souls and not for their own glory or benefit. Those who are faithful in fleshly ways are aware of the eyes of others more than those of the Lord. They seek their own honor and benefit rather than that of the church and souls. Such people might seem to be very faithful for some time, but usually they change their minds over a period of time.

For those who love God, even though their work is not recognized, they are satisfied if it is just the Lord alone who recognizes them. They are happy if they can just pay back the grace of the Lord even just a little bit. When God searches all throughout the earth to find His true workers, I hope He will be happy with you saying, "That child will fulfill this duty with My heart!"

Secondly, those who love God try to become sanctified.

If you love somebody, you are very interested in that person. You want to find out what food they like, what color they like, what kinds of gifts would make them happy, and actually make them happy.

It's the same with those who love God. They always try to understand God's heart and will thinking, "How can I please God?" "What does the Father want me to do now?" What is it that God desires of us the most and that makes Him the happiest? It's our holiness.

1 Thessalonians 4:3 first part says, "For this is the will of God, your sanctification." 3 John 1:4 says, "I have no greater joy than this, to hear of my children walking in the truth." In addition to these verses there are many parts of the Bible that advise us to be holy and sanctified.

While I was reading the Bible

when I was a new-believer, I wrote down all the commands that tell us the specific things to do, not do, to keep, or cast away. I prayed about those things and crossed out the points that I achieved. I lived with prayers and fasting to uproot the sinful nature itself from my heart. Then I received a calling to become a pastor and came to perform with so many powerful works and established a mega church with 11,000 branch churches, but I never stopped thinking that it was enough. I looked back on myself constantly and tried to achieve perfection thinking, "Is this perfect in the sight of God? What would the Lord do in this situation?"

Until the Lord comes back our fervor for holiness must not cool down. We should run towards sanctification with joy and thankfulness. We should resemble God and recover the lost image of God with joy and gratefulness.

You should not stand still thinking you work harder and more faithfully than before, but you should spend more time on the works of God. Although you are on the rock of faith, even achieved spirit and whole spirit, you should continue to try hard to be blameless. You should check if you really fight against sins to the point of shedding blood. Do you really try to abstain from every form of evil, consider others better than you, seek others' benefits, and do whatever you do for the glory of God? Do you show virtuous generosity in your words and deeds to others? You should check with these.

Thirdly, those who love God love the souls.

What God cares about the most during the human cultivation is the there are some souls who have accepted the Lord in good faith

and try hard, while other souls do not think they have the strength to pray or the strength to practice the Word. Some of them are suffering in the midst of tests and trials. In this world, there are so many souls who are going the way of death.

Those who understand the heart of God cannot turn their faces away from these people. They will diligently preach the gospel, counsel the souls, and help those in need. They give strength to and comfort the weak and care for them so they can live by God's Word. When they see the souls who commit sins, they lament in intercession.

At the time of the Exodus the sons of Israel experienced so many wondrous things including the Ten Plagues, but they complained every time they had a difficulty during the exodus. They even tried to stone Moses. What would you do if you were Moses? Would you give up on them thinking, "I tried my best but they are helpless. I cannot change them with my own strength?"

Moses put his own life up for them. Exodus 32:32 says, "But now, if You will, forgive their sin and if not, please blot me out from Your book which You have written!"

Apostle Paul suffered from hardships that men cannot bear and he went through so many lifethreatening situations, but he did not care for himself. He just focused on spreading the gospel of the Lord so just one more soul could be saved. Your heart should be filled with such love.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I hope that you will keep on trying to change and reach the full measure of faith. I pray in the name of the Lord that you will achieve the heart of the Lord who shed His souls themselves. In the church, tears for weak and dying souls and try hard to lead them to the way of salvation.

The Kind of Fervor That Pleases God

It seems you have been diligently trying hard to be faithful in your work, but what kind of fruit are you bearing? Your spiritual level may be lower than what you expected, and some of you are still in the middle of trials. Let's now check if your fervor was the kind of fervor that God takes delight in. In doing so, let's make the seeds of faith you sow be borne as fruit of perfect blessings.

POINT 1

Does your fervor come from your love for God?

Some people are born with very active characters. They are responsible for their duties. They fervently participate in church activities. They show their fervor because they want to be recognized by others. But if they do not really see what they are doing, they might deceive themselves into thinking, "I am doing the work of God because I love God."

Those who are fervent in their love for God will seek the heart and will of God to determine what God really wants from them. They do not follow the ways they may

POINT 2

Is your fervor unchangingly truthful?

Some people look very full of grace and appear fervent in their faith, but soon they are nowhere to be seen. Their passion cools down if things are not in agreement with their thoughts or their personal benefit.

Some others begin to neglect their life of faith because their mind is taken away by money or fame and other thoughts of the world. In other cases, they are diligent in their faith because they want to receive an answer from God such as divine healing or financial blessings, but their fervor cools down as quickly as not receiving an answer in the time and way they want. Some people attend all the meetings and serve their groups with money and physical service, because they long for the titles of the group.

consider to be good, and they do not try to achieve the goals they desire. They seek the goals and methods of God, and try to obey according to His heart and will.

You should be desperate and earnest for a greater measure of faith because you love God so much and you want to become a true child of God. Yet there are some people who think, "I've been as diligent as others, so why is it that I am considered lower in faith?" Or, "Since I hold the position I am in, I should have a level of my measure of faith so I don't have to be embarrassed about it." If you have this attitude it shows you want to fulfill your will.

If you want to fulfill your will before God's, you might learn the Word and pray diligently for some time but get tired and lose momentum if you do not get the results that you want. You may pray for one or two months, but if nothing goes as you want, you just stop. The reason for your diligence in prayer is neither of faith nor in love for God.

If you are doing your duties with true love for God, you will pursue peace with everybody. When you do your church duties, you should check whether you are doing it because you want to earn others' praise or because you really love God.

Also, you will not only do the works that are seen by others, but also the unseen works that are difficult and uncomfortable with a thankful heart. Even if you are sometimes wrongfully blamed for something that you did, you just quietly look to God.

But if they do not get the positions they wanted, they do not come to the meetings any more. There are some people who actively participate only when they are in charge, but they do not cooperate and may even step aside and just watch when other people are in charge.

The Apostle Paul's fervor for the spreading of the gospel never cooled down during his ministry. Even when he did not gain any glory or substantial fruit, he was not disheartened. Even though his people, the Jews, followed him everywhere in attempts to kill him and the gentiles persecuted him saying he was interfering with the idol-worshiping, he did not stop spreading the gospel. In the church that he established with so much toil, there was news of adultery and other sins among the members, which made him grieve very much. Some workers betrayed and left him, and some others rejected him saying he was

not qualified to be an apostle.

But he did not care about any kind of hardship. He was neither tired nor disheartened. He did not complain saying, "Why do I have to go through all this? Why wouldn't the Lord help me?" He never thought: "How much longer do I have to suffer?" or "I can't take this anymore"

Even after he was almost stoned to death, he left for the next destination of his mission trip right after he regained consciousness. Even after he was beaten, covered with blood, and put in jail, he praised God with a loud voice so his voice was heard by all the inmates. Even when he was in confinement and could not freely go about preaching, he sent letters to each church to reaffirm the faith of the leaders and believers. I hope your fervor for the Lord will be acknowledged by God as being truthful and never-changing like the fervor of the Apostle Paul.

POINT 3

Does your fervor come from gratefulness for God's grace of salvation?

For your fervor to be unchanging, you must never forget the grace you received from God. Apostle Paul was so passionate in fulfilling his duty because of the grace that saved such a person as him, for he considered himself to be the foremost of all sinners.


He lived his whole life with an attitude

of thinking, "I am so grateful for the grace the grace of God given to you is much greater that saved me. I was persecuting the Lord; and now what great grace it is that the Lord gave me the duty of an apostle! How could I receive such a precious duty to spread the name of the Lord?" Although he suffered from hardship and persecution, he thought it his duty to spread the gospel and tried his best.

When you work faithfully with your gratefulness for God's grace, you will not desire praise or reward for your job well-done. Although you sacrifice and dedicate yourself, than anything you can give to God.

But the greatest grace of all the grace that you received is the grace of salvation. Especially, the world today is so full of sins, and even if you have heard the gospel and accepted the Lord, and though you may feel that you understand the will of God so clearly and you experience many powerful works it is still difficult to keep your faith. I urge you to engrave such grace more deeply so that you will become increasingly more fervent day after day.

"People Said I Became Younger Over Time!"

began to attend Gwangju Manmin Church guided by my children in January 2010. As I believe in God the Creator, I am very healthy without any disease, although I am 79.

After I started to apply Muan Sweet

Water (Exodus 15:25) on my face, age spots disappeared and people said my appearance became a lot younger. Before going to church, I had had pain over my body from hard farm work and had got acupuncture. When I had pain in my knees, I went to hospital and the doctors said I should have a surgery. After I started to go to church, however, all the symptoms disappeared!

In spring 2012, I was healed of rheumatoid arthritis. I felt pain by just touching my body, and every joint of my bones were in pain as if someone was poking me with a knife. My arms were paralyzed, so I couldn't raise them up, and I couldn't go to the restroom for myself. I had to stay on a bed. As I listened to the sermons in church, I prayed, "God can open blind eyes and revive the dead. I also want to receive healing." Relying on a cane I came to Seoul to attend Manmin Prayer Center's Divine Healing Meeting. As I attended the meeting for 12 days, I received faith from above and I became better and better day by day. I eventually threw the cane away and returned home.

In June 2014, something amazing occurred to me. All my church members were reading the Bible hard and I wanted to join in. When I was reading the Bible with magnifying lens, it became so bright before my eyes that it was as though a light was turned on in front of me. I

thought my vision was improving. As I thought, my eye sight was improving and I came to read the Bible and the church's weekly bulletin without the lenses. I can even thread a needle. Hallelujah!

I live alone farming in Sunchang, Jeonbuk Province. Some people ask me if I am lonely, but I reply, "God is alive and I have GCN. How can I be lonely?"

I cannot go to church on weekdays because Gwangju Manmin Church is far away, but I can attend Daniel Prayer Meeting and other worship services on GCN. I really like GCN programs.

On Wednesdays, I wash my hair and change my clothes after work. And I offer up Wednesday Service as if I was in church. I also join Friday All-night Service from 11 P.M. until its end at 4 A.M. praising and dancing before God. I am so happy.

I am living with hope for Heaven and fullness of the Holy Spirit because I don't have to go to the hospital anymore and I listen to the Word of God and receive Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer all the time on GCN. I say to my friends in my town, "Look at me. I don't need any medicine and I've stayed healthy since believing in God!" I did nothing for Him, but God has given me a lot of blessings. I give all thanks to Him.
