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GCN's Participation in NRB Convention and Exposition 2018

Extended the Range of Broadcasting Ministry with the Word of Life and Powerful works



National Religious Broadcasters (NRB) was established to protect Christian broadcasters' rights and interests. One thousand four hundred organizations and stations from around the world meet annually, exchange new broadcasting technologies and programs, and share vision for their ministries.

From February 26 to March 2, the NRB Convention and Exposition 2018 was held in Nashville, Tennessee in the U.S. which is a festival for Christian broadcasters from around the world. GCN participated in the convention to extend its broadcasting ministry. As a gospel-oriented TV station, GCN has produced differentiated programs based on the word of life and powerful works and has transmitted them to more than 170 countries.

On February 26, GCN attended Great Commission Reception and continued fellowship and building relationships with Dr. Michael D. Little, Principal Representative to Israel, The Christian Broadcasting Network, Inc.; Dr. Stan Jeter, Chair of NRB International Committee; Dr. Frank Wright, the former president of NRB; and Dr. Arnold Enns, President of COICOM. Bishop Dr. Sunday Onuoha, President, Vision Africa Ministries, Inc. made a request of GCN's programs and Ms. Lisa Mouradian, Director, Inspiration TV discussed their partnership with GCN (photo #8).

On 27, GCN joined Super Session where US Vice President Mike Pence spoke as a special speaker in the morning and Opening Session in the afternoon (photo #1).

On the 28th, after Dr. Jerry Johnson, President of NRB declared the opening of the convention with a ribbon-cutting ceremony (photo #6), the participants began the promotions of their programs in their booths. GCN displayed its programs about Dr. Jaerock Lee's powerful works, performances of Performing Arts Committee, and other matters of interest. There were many visitors to the booth (photos # 2, 4, 5, 7). Pastor Blagovesty Belef, President of Bulgaria Christian Television said, "We've begun to air Dr. Jaerock Lee's sermon series 'The Message of the Cross.' "By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward" (Hebrews 11:24-26).

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In the 11th chapter of Hebrews appear the forefathers of faith who pleased God with their faith. Moses also pleased Him by overcoming all hardships with faith that looked to the reward that God would give to him. Let's delve into the faith of Moses.

1. The faith that hopes for the reward of God

Some believers say that it is not right to expect the reward of God. They claim if one loves God he/she should work and volunteer without expecting anything in return, and they hold that it is not good to do something in order to be rewarded.

However, Hebrews 11:6 reads, "And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him." It indicates that only when we have faith in God who is our Rewarder can we overcome any hardship and trial. We can achieve a victory in any kind of difficult situations.

If we have faith in the reward of God, we can receive blessings and glorify God by leading many souls to salvation with those blessings. Neither is it selfish nor wrong!

2. The faith of Moses who looked to the heavenly reward

Moses was born around 1500 B.C., when the Israelites were under the miserable slavery of Egypt. As the Israelites multiplied, the Pharaoh commanded his men to kill all the new-born Israelite boys. Moses was born at this time, but his father and mother hid him at home for three months (Hebrews 11:23), and they put the child into a wicker basket and set it along the Nile. At that time, a daughter of Pharaoh found the basket and took the baby. Moses' sister Miriam who stood at a distance came to the daughter of Pharaoh and introduced to her Moses' mother as a nurse for the baby. After that Moses was adopted as a son of the Pharaoh's daughter and brought up by his natural mother in the palace.

These things did not just happen by coincidence. Everything was accomplished in accordance with God's providence. As a result, Moses learned about God the LORD of Israel from birth and was told that his people had been chosen by God. And he heard how the Israelites came to reside in Egypt and that God had promised to lead them out of there and into the land of blessing and make them a great nation.

Now, let's look into how that Moses came to have faith that looked to the rewards of God. We will examine three aspects of his faith.

1) He forsook earthly wealth and glory that he could have enjoyed as a prince of Egypt.

Moses grew up as a son of a princess in the palace of the Pharaoh, but he always desired to set his people free from the oppression of Egypt.

He once saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew. He was outraged and killed the Egyptian. When it was revealed, he had to escape from the palace and flee into wilderness. It was his choice only for God to leave behind the comfortable and wealthy

life in the palace. He would have to live as a fugitive who might lose life anytime at the hands of the Egyptian army.

Moses Looked to the Reward

Concerning this, Hebrews 11:24-26 says, "By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to endure illtreatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward."

If we have such faith as looking to the reward of God, we can give up things no matter how precious they are and take delight in hardship on account of Christ.

2) He endured any hardship and fulfilled his God-given duty.

God refined him in the wilderness for 40 years. After that God appointed him as the leader of the Israelites. God commissioned him to liberate the people and lead them into the land of Canaan.

Moses had to face many situations that may have required his life, but he only looked to God and marched forward. Because he had the faith in God, he could boldly tell the stubborn Pharaoh to set the people free. And when the Egyptian army chased the people, Moses was able to part the Red Sea by faith. The people of Israel then crossed the sea like it was dry land.

Despite all these miracles, it was not long before they began to complain and grumble against Moses. That was because they ran out of water and food. They grumbled against Moses saying that they could have lived happily in Egypt but he had led them out of Egypt to put them to death. They fully forgot how earnestly they had prayed to God that He would save them from slavery.

Moses, however, never felt frustrated or gave up the tasks commissioned by God. He looked to God who knows everything. He only looked to the rewards that God would give to him later for what he was doing. This Moses, when the Israelites complained and stood against him, repented on behalf of them and prayed to God with love saying, "But now, if You will, forgive their sin-and if not, please blot me out from Your book which You have written!" (Exodus 32:32)

For this reason, God loved Moses so much, praised him for being faithful in all the households of God and talked with him face to face like between close friends (Numbers 12). The reason God assigned Moses the duty was to refine his heart, help him accomplish the heart of Christ and to pile up heavenly rewards on earth so as to enjoy the great glory in heaven.

3) He acknowledged and relied on God in everything.

Moses prayed to God whenever he was faced with whatever kind of difficulties. That was because he believed in God. He believed that God had led His people out of Egypt with His great power, He knew all his situations, and there was nothing impossible for Him.

When wicked men blamed and rebelled against Moses, he never quarreled or disputed against them but only committed everything into the hands of the just God. When Korah rebelled against Moses together with two hundred fifty leaders of the congregation, Moses prayed to God and the earth opened and swallowed them up alive (Numbers 16:1-33).

Just as God worked with Moses, God works for us according to our faith when we acknowledge and rely on God in every matter.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I urge you to possess the faith looking to the reward of God as Moses did and set your hope on heaven and work faithfully in all aspects. I pray in the name of the Lord that you will enjoy eternal glory in heaven.

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Three Tips to Clearly Hear the Holy Spirit

When you repent and accept Jesus Christ, God sends the Holy Spirit the Helper into your heart as a gift. Romans 8:14-15 reads, "For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, 'Abba! Father!'" As written, God's children who received the Holy Spirit can hear what the Holy Spirit says to them and be led by Him.

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The voice of the Spirit is not heard through your ears, but through your heart. And since He is the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), He works through the truth. Thus, to hear His word, you have to cultivate your heart with truth first. When you pay attention to His voice, even if it is faint, and obey Him, you can fill your heart with truth and hear Him better and better. Moreover, if you receive the fullness of the Spirit by fervent prayers, you can hear Him much better and more clearly.

That is, you can hear the Holy Spirit more clearly and better as you grow in faith by cultivating truth in your heart. Now let's delve more into what we should do to hear the voice of the Spirit well and be led by Him.

You should try to discern the will of God with a truthful heart.

You cannot clearly hear the Spirit's word for you if you put your situation or condition you are in before His word. In this case, you may think, 'I like this better. The reality of it is so difficult.' If you have such thoughts rather than discern the will of God first with a truthful heart, you have difficulty hearing what the Spirit says to you clearly and being guided by Him. obey unconditionally as long as it is in the will of God. You must pray with faith that God will achieve even what seems impossible as long as you obey. In such prayer with faith, you can hear the word of the Spirit.

Thus, you must have the heart to

You must not use fleshly thoughts caused by self-framework, self-righteousness, and speculations.

Suppose one has strong selfrighteousness and received much grace from the sermon about Daniel's integrity. He established his own self-righteousness like 'No compromise in truth whatsoever!' Then, he might use it as the standard for everything. He might insist that people should never compromise and might break peace with them. Such people usually form their selfframework, self-righteousness, and speculations and mistakenly think of them as truth. Then, they cannot hear what the Spirit says even when He teaches them truth. They seem to lead diligent believing lives outwardly, but they are likely to be faced with limit and stuck in a certain level of faith. Therefore, when you work for the kingdom of God, you should apply different methods that are proper according to each person's faith and situation. You should not stubbornly insist on your idea since you may mistake it for truth. Even if you think you heard the word of the Spirit, you should check according to the truth if it is real.

You should obey what the Spirit says and what He urges you to do.

Even new believers can hear what the Spirit says as long as they listen to the Word of God and try to keep it diligently. But most people fail to bear in mind the Word and keep it. That is why they cannot continue to hear the voice of the Spirit.

If you continually disobey what the Spirit tells you, you cannot experience the work of God and later you will not be able to hear His voice anymore. If you cannot hear what He says, you may have no relation to salvation.

When God's children commit the sins leading to death, they will feel afraid and tremble at first because the Spirit groans in their heart. But as they ignore it and commit such sins again and again, their heart may become numb and they will come to have no fear. They will end up in spiritual death. Their consciences will have been seared with a branding iron, and thus they will follow their own benefits and desires. They will fall deep into sins. Then, they may be put into a situation where they cannot repent and turn back from sin. They will eventually lead to spiritual death.

When you hear the voice of the Spirit and receive His guidance, unless you obey, you cannot say that you are led by Him. Only when you obey His word, however insignificant, can you hear Him more clearly and be led exactly by Him. Therefore, you should cast off untruthful heart quickly in the fullness of the Spirit, have only spiritual thoughts, and hear and obey what the Spirit says to you. Then, you can always be led to the way of blessings. The most fundamental secret to hearing the voice of the Spirit is achieving a sanctified heart. When you become sanctified and resemble God, your will and heart will be in accord with that of God and then you can naturally be led by the Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 5:21-24 reads, "But examine everything carefully; hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil. Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass." Thus, we should become sanctified quickly, communicate with the Spirit clearly, and finish the adornment as the Lord's bride.

I had led a believing life for a long time, but it felt like



On February 1, 2018, I was talking to my daughter on the phone. She was on a business trip. She said she had talked about the trip before, but I could not remember it at all. My daughter sensed something strange from me and she told her daughter to take me to hospital. I had a medical checkup in the neurological medicine department.

The doctor asked a few questions and told me to move my hands and legs. He said I had already experienced a stroke and it could be cerebral infarction and transient global amnesia. He had me hospitalized immediately. I looked back on that day. I remembered wearing my shoes to go home after the district prayer meeting, but I could not remember everything that happened afterwards.

The next day a Brain MRA was conducted. The doctor examined the result and said that the brain stem, (which is a tube connecting cerebrum with the spinal cord and carrying nutrition to brain), was severed at its upper part. I was sent to a ward room. I heard later that after I went to the room the doctor told my family members that I did not have many days to live. He told them to just commit everything to heaven.

When I heard that I had a problem with my brain, I thought I might be a burden to my family members in that instant but I relied on God with a prayerful heart. I looked back upon my past. I reflected upon my lack of diligence and deeds for God although my family had received so much grace from Senior Pastor Dr. Jaerock Lee since we registered in Manmin. I felt so sorry and tearfully repented.

That evening with the help of my family, I sent my prayer request to Senior Pastor who was praying in the mountain prayer house. I thought everything would be okay because of his prayer and felt relieved. I slept peacefully.

The next day I had the brain MRA conducted again and felt so surprised at such amazingly quick work of God. The doctor said to me, "You did a good job. The result is very good. Congratulations." He added that blood flowed well all through my brain and nutrition was being provided to my brain.

The result showed that the part of my brainstem that had been severed had become reconnected. I asked if there were chances that my brain stem would be narrowed again. He said no. He said there would be no problem with my brain. Hallelujah!

Through the Senior Pastor's prayer I was able to leave the hospital after five days of hospitalization. I felt like I regained a new life. Now I am full of thanks. When I praise, many tears flow down on my face. I pray in Special Daniel Prayer Meeting and distribute *Manmin News* to my neighbors. I am trying to lead a diligent Christian life to repay the grace of God.

I give all thanks and glory to God who let me experience the power of healing and is filling me with faith and hope. I extend my heartfelt thanks to Senior Pastor who prayed for me.
