Home, Local, Branch Churches All Over the World

Many people's lives are changed through the gospel all over the world. When they experience the works of the living God, home churches, local sanctuaries, and branch churches, and furthermore denominations are formed all over the world.

"I listened to the 'Measure of Faith' sermons of Rev. Jaerock Lee on a Christian channel. I was deeply touched by the message for I haven't heard such a message anywhere else. Since then, I kept on listening to Rev. Lee's sermons on the Internet. I got assurance of salvation. Sometimes I listened to them all-night," says Hector Ayala (41, Male) from Honduras. He began to have worship services with other believers at each other's homes who loved to listen to Rev. Lee's sermons.

And they experienced the power of God through Rev. Lee's prayers. They were healed of spinal pain and skin diseases. The number of believers was added and finally, they established a Manmin local sanctuary in San Pedro Sula in March 2018.

116 Associative Churches in Venezuela

Victor Giménez (45, Male) was also blessed by Rev. Jaerock Lee's sermons on the Internet including Message of the Cross, Heaven, and Hell. He delivered these messages to his acquaintances and finally, they opened a local sanctuary in Guayana city in March 2018. And then, 2 more local sanctuaries opened.

They attend the Sunday worship services and Daniel Prayer Meeting every night on YouTube channel of Colombia Manmin Church. They also experience divine healing and their life problems getting resolved.

Pastors' seminars and handkerchief crusades were held in various states of Venezuela with the speaker Pastor David Jang of Colombia Manmin Church. As a result, 116 churches registered as associative churches of Manmin.

There are also many others who were blessed by Rev. Jaerock Lee's sermons on Enlace TV, the biggest Christian channel in Spanish speaking countries. They experienced God's power, accepted the Lord and live new lives.

In Colombia, 4 local sanctuaries were set up in Sonso, Sogamoso, Palmira, and Bucaramanga. They also attend the Sunday worship service and prayer meetings



through live-broadcast on YouTube channel of Colombia Manmin Church.

Denominations in Manmin's name in Russia, Moldova

As anti-terrorism act has been in effect in Russia, religious activities have been quite restrained. However, in December 2018, 'Manmin Ministries', a church union of Christian evangelical religious body, was registered in the Dept. of Justice in Russia.

This goes back to 2003 Russia United Crusade with Rev. Jaerock Lee. Pastor Vladimir Osipov was blessed in the crusade and registered as a Manmin branch church. He spread Manmin's ministry to leading pastors in Kaliningrad and Western Ural area.

Those leading pastors visited our church and witnessed power of God in person. They gained vision to awaken Russian souls being with Manmin. They've been praying with Pastor Vladimir to have a denomination registered and it came to fruition.

In Moldova, a home church started through believers who were blessed by Rev. Jaerock Lee's sermons. Their devotion and passion made it into a branch church. Recently, they were able to register their church in the denomination 'Manmin', an evangelical church union.

70 Home Churches in India

The number of home churches in India is on the rise, thanks to the believers who are blessed and healed by Rev. Jaerock Lee's sermons on GCNTV Hindi channel on YouTube. Hundreds of prayer requests, testimonies, and counseling calls are received every month in Delhi Manmin Church, ministered by Pastor John Kim.

Rita (60, Female) is an elementary school principal. After getting involved in a traffic accident, she couldn't walk and was bed-ridden. However, she watched the Special Healing Session of April in Manmin Central Church on GCNTV Hindi channel. After that, she listened to all 24 sermons of the Message of the Cross and kept the Lord's Day. In the healing session of May, she was enabled to walk again. Many others works of the Holy Spirit are taking place, which led to starting of 70 home churches.

Blessed Are Those Who Mourn

“Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.”
Matt. 5:4

There are many people who suffer from financial hardships or pains of sicknesses. Some are heart-broken because things don't go as they planned. Some others shed bitter tears because they are betrayed by others.

But the mourning for personal reasons is not in accordance with God's will. It is fleshly mourning coming from one's own evil and emotions, and these people can't be comforted by God. On the contrary, those who have faith can rejoice always in the Lord.

Some might ask how they can rejoice when they're going through hardships. However, God's children have received salvation and the promise of kingdom of heaven, and thus, they can rejoice and give thanks. Also, they believe that, if they pray with faith, God will cause all things to work for good.

What God wants is spiritual mourning. Matt. 5:4 says, “Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.” Here, mourning should be for the kingdom and righteousness of God. Now, let us take a closer look at what spiritual mourning is.

1. 2nd Gateway to True Blessing: Those Who Mourn

1) Mourning of Repentance

When we believe in Jesus Christ and accept Him as our Savior, we by the help of the Holy Spirit realize in our heart that He was crucified for our sins. When we feel His love, we shed tears with great repentance.

Repenting is to turn from the sinful ways completely and to live by God's word. If we mourn in repentance, the burden of sins will be taken away, and we will experience upspring of joy.

However, we're not perfect until we reach the full measure of faith. In the meantime, we commit sins and mourn with repentance. Those who love God will repent with many tears because they feel very sorry before God. The power to cast away sins comes down from above when we have such mourning.

Some believers commit the same sin again and again and repent repeatedly. It's either they're slow to change or they don't change at all. They

think they mourn with repentance but they don't actually do it from the heart.

We shouldn't just mourn with words but we have to bear the fruit of repentance (Luke 3:8). Furthermore, as our faith matures and becomes a leader in the church, we shouldn't have to be mourning with repentance any longer. It means we should've cast away sins so that we won't have to mourn.

We mourn with repentance when we don't do our God-given duties. The important thing is that it might create a barrier against God if we don't repent, and God might not be able to protect us. But if we repent and mourn from the heart, God-given joy and peace will come upon us. We'll also gain the confidence and strength to do our duties. This is the comfort of God given to those who mourn.

2) Mourning for Brothers in Faith

Sometimes, brothers in faith commit sins and go the way of death. Those who have mercy will mourn for them, considering it their own business. They'll repent for them and pray with love so that they can act according to the truth. Such an act is possible only with love for the souls. God is pleased with such prayers of mourning and gives His comfort.

However, there are also those believers who pass judgment and hurt other people's feelings rather than praying for them with mourning. They spread other people's faults. Such acts are not right in the sight of God. We should just cover the fault of others and pray for them so that they won't commit sins.

In Acts chapter 7, Stephen was being stoned to death by the Jews and yet he prayed for those who were stoning him (Acts 7:59-60). Jesus was crucified receiving all kinds of mockeries, and He prayed for those who were crucifying Him (Luke 23:34). This shows the great and deep love of Jesus for the souls.

If we can pray for the forgiveness of other people's sins, it is pleasing in the sight of God.

3) Mourning for Winning the Souls

God's children should have the love toward

those souls that are going the way of destruction in this sinful world. Today's generation is as evil as or more evil than Noah's generation that was punished by the flood and the Sodom and Gomorrah that were punished by fire from heaven. We should have the mourning for our family members, relatives, and neighbors who are not saved yet. We should mourn for our nations and churches and everything that hinders the kingdom of God.

The apostle Paul always had concerns and mourning for the kingdom of God and the souls. He was persecuted so much while spreading the gospel. He was put in jail. But rather, he praised God (Acts 16:25). But for the kingdom of God and the souls, he always mourned (Acts 20:31; 2 Cor. 11:28-29).

We should mourn when believers do not live by the word of God or when churches are not able to glorify God's name. If we are persecuted for the name of the Lord, we shouldn't fall into despair feeling it is hard but pray and mourn for those souls that are persecuting us.

Furthermore, as we see darkness covers the world more increasingly, we should pray more earnestly and with more mourning, for God's glory to be revealed and many souls to be saved.

2. Spiritual Mourning Calls for Spiritual Love

John 6:63 says “It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing..” Only the kind of love that God acknowledges can give life and lead the souls to salvation. Therefore, in order to have spiritual mourning, we should first have spiritual love in our heart.

Love can be categorized into fleshly love and spiritual love. Fleshly love seeks one's own; it changes, perishes, and is meaningless, whereas spiritual love is never changing. It's the love within the word of God. It serves interest of others even by sacrificing oneself.

Spiritual love can't be possessed by human effort. It can be given only when we realize God's love and walk in the truth. God gives abundant blessings to those who have spiritual love with which they can love even their enemies and give

life for them. These people will give life so that numerous souls will return to the Lord.

We can pray in mourning for the souls only when we have spiritual love in us. Then, we can give life and faith even to the souls with hardened heart, so that they will be changed.

When we have spiritual love, we will mourn spiritually for the kingdom and righteousness of God. Then, as Matt. 6:33 says, "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you," the souls will be transformed and God's kingdom will be accomplished.

3. Blessing for Those Who Spiritually Mourn

Matt. 5:4 writes, "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted." As written, those who spiritually mourn will be comforted by God.

The comfort of God is different from that of the world. 1 John 3:18 says, "Little children, let us not love with word or with tongue, but in deed and truth." God's comfort is not just in words but very substantial.

He gives financial blessing to those who are poor. He gives healing to those who are sick. He answers those who pray to receive their hearts' desires.

He gives the strength to those who are not able to fulfill their church duties. If they mourn for the souls, God gives them fruits of evangelism and revival. Furthermore, to those who rend their heart and mourn to cast away sins, He gives them the grace of forgiveness. God blesses them to show the power of God like the apostle Paul to the extent that they become holy.

Moreover, God gives them comfort. God's comfort is unimaginable. He gives us what we

need the most and abundantly. He gives us rewards in heaven, too. It is true blessing.

Rev. 21:4 says, "and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away." He gives us all the glory and rewards in heaven where there are no tears, sorrow, or pain.

I had some pain in the back in 2000. It became increasingly more frequent. When I couldn't bear the pain, I vomited, and I felt better. I knew it was due to indigestion then. I felt uncomfortable constantly, but when it suddenly got worse, I couldn't eat well, and I lost a lot of weight.


In 2011, I took a gastroscopy in Korea. The doctor said my gastric ulcer was so serious that it could cause a perforation in the stomach. When the symptoms were very bad, I received Rev. Jaerock Lee's prayer for the sick and it would get better, but it wasn't completely healed. I felt increasingly sorer as time went by, particularly because I couldn't work as faithfully as I could in the missionary field due to health problem.

In the spring of 2019, I realized I didn't really show my faith even though I said I wanted to get healed by faith. I repented of every shortcoming I realized. I also

prayed with the handkerchief on which Rev. Jaerock Lee prayed (Acts 19:11-12) frequently.

Then, the condition got better without my notice, and I could eat much better recently. I came to visit Korea in May and took another gastroscopy. It showed the ulcer was almost healed and there is only a trace of it. Hallelujah!

Church Welfare Counseling Center

Church Welfare Counseling Center has been operational from this past June 9. Currently active social workers counsel the church members who are in need of social benefits and connect them with the actual government agencies that can help them.

The counseling varies from basic living expenses, various pensions, government supports, senior citizen care policies, child care services, etc. the office is located the opposite of New Comers' Welcoming Room (shared with legal office). The working hours are from 1:30 PM to 2:20 PM on Sundays, before and after Wednesday services, and before Friday all-night services. Telephone counseling is available during the weekdays (02-818-7093).

The Welfare Counseling Office is planning to open an Internet Café to post counsel cases and to share the government policies and benefits. They also plan to have presentation for all church members regarding the social welfare benefits.

Awards in Composition and Painting Competition



Sudokwon Ilbo and Sisa News are holding the awards ceremony of the 16th Namhansanseong Cultural Festival national students' composition and painting competition in the memorial hall of the National Assembly.

From our church, Nayeong Ki won the Education Minister's Award and Joochang Choi won the Parliament Member's Award. A total of 54 children won the awards (46 in painting and 8 in composition) including Seoul City Mayor's Award and Seoul Education Authority Award.

Since around 10 years ago I couldn't hear well with my right ear. I misunderstood people often. In November 2018 I received a diagnosis that I had to wear a hearing aid.

I wanted to be healed by the Lord, and I looked back on my life. In January 2008, I had cerebral infarction. I couldn't move left side of the body. I came to have depression, too. I happened to hear the praise music coming out from Mongolia Manmin Church and registered there.

In April the same year, I received prayer with the handkerchief on which Rev. Jaerock Lee prayed (Act 19:11-12) and cerebral infarction and depression were completely healed.

I wasn't getting the healing of impaired hearing although I experienced the great power of God, so I determined to get the healing by faith once again. There was a mission delegation from Manmin Central Church in May coming to Mongolia, so I prepared myself. I read the Bible again and did voluntary services in the church. I tried to do everything that would please God.

On May 17, we had the handkerchief

crusade in Ulaanbaatar Manmin Church. When I received the handkerchief prayer, I felt very hot. I closed my left ear and tried to hear with the right ear. I could

hear much better, and it became increasingly better. Now, I can hear clearly, and my left ear can hear better than before, too.

Furthermore, I had liver cirrhosis,

and my stomach would swell up like I was pregnant when I was tired. But the conditions got much better, too. I've been also healed of high BP, and even without medicines, I feel light all over my body.

My daughter Anhzaya had pain in her sides due to pyelonephritis. She had fever every morning and couldn't get up well.

However, she prayed earnestly in the 2-term Consecutive Special Daniel Prayer Meeting in 2019. She received the fire of the Holy Spirit through the Senior Pastor's prayer on the last day March 31.

I give all thanks and glory to God the Father and our Lord for giving us good health and faith and joy.

My life was filled with unhappiness before I accepted the Lord. The business went bankrupt in 1993. We had a great amount of debt that my husband and I worked together to pay, but it was not enough.

We lived in a small room attached to the shop, so we prayed about getting a house. In 2017, we could move into a good house near the shop.

However, in March 2018, another vegetable/fruit shop opened opposite ours. I felt uncomfortable. And yet I prayed, “God, let both the shops have good sales!” And then, to my surprise, our daily sales increased by 70-80% and we got more regular customers, too.

We have a peaceful family in the Lord. Our daughter is a member of Love Dancing Team, and our son also got promoted recently. We give all thanks and glory to God who is full of grace.
