Due to the government's cancellation of the corona emergency, our Kinshasa Manmin

Church has been offering on-site worship while complying with the quarantine regulations since August 16th. Moreover, I'm grateful that our members attend the worship services voluntarily even though we couldn't operate the van vehicle nor provide transportation expenses. Even though I announced to worship under the guidance of the pastors or church leaders in each region in areas far from the church, there were also members who came to the church as they longed for it.

Over the past five months, our members have grown in faith through reading and memorizing the Bible, studying the 'The Message of the Cross' and praying. We record GCN broadcasts to conduct Wednesday and Friday all-night worship service, and the Daniel prayer meeting is held for an hour from 5 pm.

We share some of the testimonies of our members who experienced healing or protection. Brother Eva (age 31) had severe pain and swollen right hand due to lymphedema, so he went to the hospital and Dr. said that treatment was difficult there.

It was difficult for me to move around the city due to the control of the coronavirus, but the visit was desperate, so I visited the house of Brother Eva and prayed with a powerful handkerchief (Acts 19:11-12) on which Dr. Jaerock Lee prayed. At that time, he felt his body heated by the fire of the Holy







After Brother Eva received the prayer, the pain and the swelling from the lymphedema in his right hand disappeared, and he glorifies God with his testimony.

Spirit, and the pain and the swelling disappeared and he was healed cleanly.

Brother Tresor (age 33) was in a taxi on his way home from work, but was hit by a taxi from behind him. He testified that there were five people in the taxi and only the taxi driver and Brother Tresor were not injured, and rather they had taken three passengers injured in an accident to the hospital. I thank Father God of love who always keeps us with blazing eyes.

Last August, churches leaders and bishops of the denomination had a meeting in Kaliningrad despite the COVID-19 situation. Pastors from other denominations

I was invited to deliver a message and to lead a closing prayer. I also discussed with other bishops the matter of organizing the association of evangelical churches in Saint Petersburg. It was a very meaningful and blissful meeting.

I started running a small restaurant in early 2018. The acquaintance already decided to sell the convenience store to someone else because he thought I could not afford it, but the acquaintance and the person who was supposed to take over the convenience store understood my situation, and so I could take over store. Hallelujah!

This store has a stable sale profit from lottery tickets and cigarettes, which is helpful to run the store. In addition, by operating a food truck in the parking lot behind the store, I can sell other various foods. Today, the blessings keep adding up as the sales increase thanks to delivery app services, and in-house restaurant customers.

During my immigration life, God has been a refuge for me, who suffered from several business failures and difficulties in life. I give thanks and glory to God who leads me to the way of blessing when all the doors seem to be closed.

The Message of the Cross (22)

People without Salvation despite Their Confession of Faith in God

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter" (Matthew 7:21).

"...There is a sin leading to death; I do not say that he should make request for this" (1 John 5:16).

In Matthew 25 we find a story of five "prudent" virgins who prepared "oil in flasks along with their lamps" and another five "foolish" virgins "took no oil with them." At the arrival of the bridegroom was announced, the foolish virgins went to purchase oil but when they returned, the door to the wedding banquet had already been shut.

Here, the ten virgins signify all believers with hopes for Heaven and "the bridegroom" symbolizes Jesus Christ. The important lesson here is that of the ten, only the "prudent" five entered the wedding banquet and the rest could not. Like the latter five, some believers will not receive salvation. What kind of believers, among those who confess their faith in God, will fail to receive salvation and enter Heaven?

1. People Who Practice Lawlessness

Matthew 7:21 says, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter."

In the following Verses 22-23 Jesus continues: "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness." Even if people proclaim their faith in the Lord and perform miraculous acts, He will say, "I never knew you," to all those "who practice lawlessness."

At the end of the world—on the Day of Judgment—our Lord will set apart all the unrighteous who have practiced lawlessness and even caused others to falter, and throw them into the furnace of fire that is the punishment of Hell (Matthew 13:40-42).

What did Jesus mean by "lawlessness"? As 1 John 3:4 tells us, "Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness," lawlessness, or

sin, stems from disobeying the law of the truth, which is God's Word itself. Lawless people are those who do the things that are forbidden in the Bible; those who do not cast off the things the Bible directs them to cast off; those who fail to do what the Bible prescribes for them to do; and those who do not keep or obey what the Bible commands them to keep or obey.

The Bible further elaborates on this in 1 Corinthians 6:9-10, "Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God." Despite one's confession of faith in the Lord, if he keeps practicing lawlessness without turning from sin, he will be unable to inherit Heaven and thus end up in Hell (Galatians 5:19-21).

Some of you may ask, "If a novice Christian told a lie and if he's unable to receive salvation on account of that lie, how many people will actually receive salvation?" Of course, just because an individual has just accepted the Lord, it does not mean he is able to cast off all of his sins right away. Even if the person has not cast off all his sins, when he prays, makes every effort, and is transformed accordingly, God will recognize that effort alone to be the proof of faith worthy of salvation.

However, if the person does not even try to cast off sins but actually keeps on sinning and becomes even more drenched in worldly ways, his confession, "I believe," becomes a lie.

2. People Who Commit Sins Leading to Death

1 John 5:16 reads, "...There is a sin leading to death; I do not say that he should make request for this."

We are to diligently encourage and pray for those

who have committed sins that will not lead to death and help them turn away from sins but there are also other sins that lead to death. What kinds of sins, then, lead people to death?

In Matthew 12:31 Jesus reminds us explicitly, "Therefore I say to you, any sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven people, but blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven," and again in Luke 12:10, "And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him."

"Blaspheming against the Holy Spirit" is to blasphemy against and label the Holy Spirit "the devil" or "Satan" and deeming the works of God as manifested by the Holy Spirit to be works of demons and Satan.

"Interfering with the Holy Spirit" is to prevent the works of God from taking place through one's denial of God's works from his own evil even after witnessing firsthand the works of the Holy Spirit.

For instance, spreading baseless rumors and making unfounded accusations by calling a congregation filled with the works of the Holy Spirit "heretic" or "in the wrong" is an act of "interfering with the Holy Spirit." This is a truly grave and frightening sin for it is to challenge God the Creator interfering with and thwarting His kingdom from becoming fulfilled.

People who take this a step further and coming up with schemes and actually carrying them out, thereby intensifying of the blaspheming against the Holy Spirit will commit the sin of "speaking against the Holy Spirit." Featured in Mark 3:20-30 is a scene in which the Jews blasphemy against, interfere with, and speak against the Holy Spirit. Among the people who had heard the news of Jesus, good people believed in Him and gave glory to God. Evil ones, however, were busy creating evil rumors and spread them and such an effort was spearheaded prominently by the scribes and the Pharisees who boasted their deep knowledge of the Scripture. They said, "He has lost His senses" and "He is possessed by Beelzebul."

Jesus called them to Himself and spoke to them in parables, "How can Satan cast out Satan? If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. If a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. If Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished!" For there is a strict order even in the world of evil spirits, demons do not drive out from people other demons, and Satan does not drive out itself.

Furthermore, as Jesus continues in Verses 28-29, "Truly I say to you, all sins shall be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they utter; but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin," how can someone receive salvation if he has blasphemed against, interfered with, and spoken against the works of God and called them "works of demons"?

God who is the same yesterday, today, and forever shows signs and wonders even today through people with whom He is pleased (John 4:48), and affirms His existence and presence through them. Therefore, you must not blaspheme against, interfere with, and speak against the Holy Spirit.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I pray in the name of the Lord that through this message you will come to fathom that one may not receive salvation despite his confession of faith in God, and one must stay clear off this path to death, and arrive safely at Heaven by taking the straight way!

I was the youngest among 2 brothers and 3 sisters in a very poor family. I got a job right after I graduated from my high school, and I lived diligently saving the most of what I earned for a better future.

In 1998, when I was 25, I became a member of Daejoen Manmin Church. Soon, I attended the "2 Week Special Revival Meeting" in Manmin Central Church in Seoul. There I received Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer for the sick, and I was healed of bronchitis and came to have faith.

I used to be prone to cold and stomachupset, but I became healthy after I became a Christian. In 2000, I married to a woman who led me to God, and we had a son. I attended various services, and Daniel Prayer meeting. I served God in a choir, and drove cars for church members.

In 2013, my wife, Deaconess Yihaw Kim was healed of various diseases such as lymphadenitis, gonarthritis, dry eye, and many pains when she received Dr. Jaerock Lee's prayer for the sick in the summer retreat.

In 2017, my family moved to Seoul for my son (Brother Taeho Kim), and all of my family registered to Manmin Central Church. In Divine Healing Meeting, February, 2019, my son was healed of atopic dermatitis and hyperhidrosis thanks to Pastor Soojin Lee's handkerchief prayer. He receives scholarship every term. All the happiness that I am enjoying now is by the grace of God.

Last June, I experienced the living God again. I was working on the top of an elevator which was in the 3rd floor. The chain that was holding the elevator came untied, and the elevator fell down to the ground floor.

My co-worker fell down to the 1st floor along with the elevator. His spine got ruptured, and went to a surgery to hold his spine with metal pins. Mysteriously though, I was bounced off to the 3rd floor, and I was OK except some bruises. People around me thought it was very strange.

If my body had not been bounced off, but stuck in the elevator door, my body would have been cut in two, and lost my life.

Since I believe in God, I've been protected like this in this world which is full of accidents. I receive God's blessings both in spirit and in flesh.

20 years ago, I had no hope, but a saving account. Since I met the Lord, I've never envied a rich man, but live a peaceful life with hope for heaven. I give all thanks and glory to good God, and to the Lord who saved me.

Under the influence of my parents who served many idols, I naturally followed them. However, while attending Mongolia Manmin Church, I realized that it was the wrong path, through Dr. Jaerock Lee's sermon. After I drastically burned idols, I received many blessings.

My husband was evangelized and quit drinking and smoking cold turkey. He was healed of severe acne on his neck, and last year, he was also healed of a hand eczema that he had suffered for several years. My eldest son, who had been studying in China, could not return to Mongolia due to visa issues, and was arrested by the Chinese immigration office and had to pay a large fine. Last Summer, I had severe stomachache. But during Manmin Summer Retreat, when Pastor Soojin Lee prayed with the handkerchief of power (Acts 19:11-12) that the Senior Pastor had prayed, I felt heat in my stomach and the pain disappeared. I don't have any problem since.

Whenever I think of the grace of the Lord that has worked in my life, I feel joy springing up within me. Although I am an ordinary housewife, when grace and emotion come to me uncontrollably, I express my love to the Lord by writing and composing praise songs.

I give all thanks and glory to God the Father for healing my family, and to the Lord for giving us a new day full of thanks and joy.
