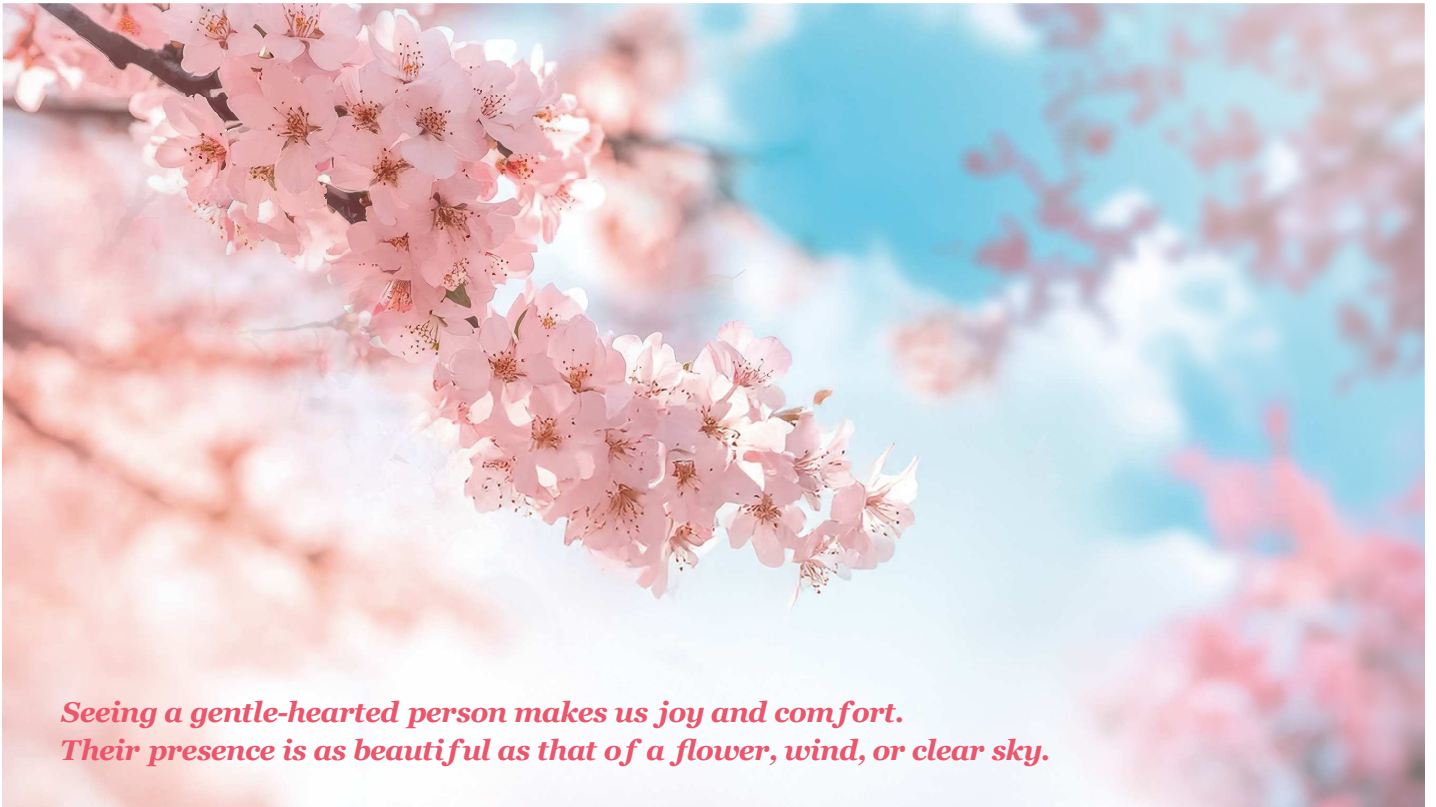

I was healed of a herniated disc, for which I could hardly go to work.

On November 7, 2024, I was about to lift up a heavy container of kimchi the weight of 20kg to throw it away into the apartment food waste bin. At that instant a “thud” sound was heard from my back. The sound was so clear I could hear it, and the pain was so severe that I couldn’t straighten my back or move it.

I received Senior Pastor Soojin Lee’s prayer for the sick recorded on the phone, and the pain immediately subsided a little. I was barely able to finish work and come back home. The next day, I had difficulty going to work and went to an orthopedic clinic for examination. The doctor said that my lumbar disc had ruptured and that I would have to wait a week to decide whether or not to have surgery.

On Sunday, November 10, I received



a prayer from Pastor Geumran Hwang and the pain was relieved so that I was able to go to work the next day. On November 17, my parish offered flowers on the altar and had a meeting with Senior Pastor Soojin Lee at the basement studio. When she prayed for us, I received it with faith.

The next day, I felt hot at my workplace and took off my waistband. To my surprise, I didn’t feel any pain in my waist. I tried bending and straightening my waist and going up and down the stairs. There was no more pain or discomfort. I realized that God had healed me. Hallelujah!

Additionally, God blessed me to buy a very nice house at the same price as that of a lease. I give all thanks and glory to God the Father who healed me and blessed me.

Oh! There is no more cancerous tissue in the rectum!

In June 2022, I noticed blood in my stool and went to the hospital for an endoscopy. The result showed my rectal cancer. I was so shocked by the unexpected diagnosis because I had been healthy enough to drink iced coffee even in the winter. Rectal cancer happens when a bulging tumor develops in the tube between the rectum and the anus, and it blocks smooth bowel movements.

Two months later, I went to the hospital again and the doctor said that I needed an urgent surgery, but the cancerous tissue was so large that they had to first reduce its size with chemotherapy and then to do the surgery.

Chemotherapy is the process of killing cancer cells by administering drugs into the blood vessels. Since the drugs are toxic, normal cells also die and side effects include lowered immunity, indigestion, and dysfunction, resulting in even death. However, thanks to the prayers from Senior Pastor Soojin Lee and the late Director of Manmin Prayer Center Boknim Lee, I was able to undergo four months of the chemotherapy without any side effects.



In December, the cancerous tissue became smaller, in which I could get a surgery. But the doctor told me that I should have open-abdominal surgery measuring 30 centimeters wide and 20 centimeters long and remove the rectum. And I would have to undergo restoration surgery in 4 months and have the additional chemotherapy.

I was so much shocked by the fact that I should such a huge open-abdominal surgery and there was little hope for complete recovery even after the surgery. I decided to give up on the surgery and to leave everything to God. The doctor warned me, saying, “You will get into a bigger trouble without immediate surgery.” However, I was reminded that I had been healed of cerebral infarction

and spinal fracture by faith and prayer, and threw away all kinds of medications and began praying for my healing through the power of faith.

I looked back on my past days and discovered my shortcomings even in my long years of faith. I repented that I had judged, condemned, and hated those who had caused a hard time to the church a few years ago.

While I was praying at a Daniel Prayer Meeting the late Director Boknim Lee prayed for me twice, laying her hands on me, saying, “Please burn away diseases and germs with the fire of the Holy Spirit, and heal completely.” I felt a fire flashed through my whole body.

When I attended a Divine Healing Meeting, Speaker Senior Pastor Soojin Lee prayed for the sick calling out the diseases’ lists. When she mentioned ‘rectal cancer’

in her prayer, I earnestly received her prayer, saying, “Amen! Amen!” with a longing for the eradication of my cancer.

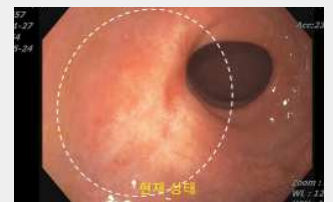
In April of 2024, I underwent comprehensive medical test including blood test, endoscopy, MRI, and CT. After the examination, the doctor said in surprise, “Oh! No more cancerous tissue at all! I can’t see any traces or roots.”

I came to a realization that my rectal cancer and all cancerous cells were burned away by the prayers from Senior Pastor Soojin Lee and the late Director Boknim Lee. Hallelujah!

There are a few acquaintances who wear diapers due to side effects of rectal cancer surgery. I was healed of my rectal cancer without surgery and have been healthy for one year and 10 months. I am so grateful for the grace and love of God the Father.

Why did they divide Jesus' outer garments and cast lots for His tunic (1)

The reason for dividing Jesus' outer garments into four parts

Before His crucifixion, Jesus was already covered in blood because He had a thorny crown on His head and was severely scourged. He carried the heavy cross on His shoulders and when He barely arrived at Golgotha, the place of execution, the Roman soldiers crucified Him and divided His outer garments into four parts. However, they did not divide His tunic but cast lots for it. Herein lies the profound providence of God.

1. The providence that divided Jesus' outer garment into four parts

John 19:23-24 records, "Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece. They said therefore among themselves, 'Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be.'"

Why did God record Jesus' outer garments and tunic in such detail? The answer can be found in the history of Israel after 70 AD.

Jesus came as the King of the Jews, and Jesus' outer garments spiritually refers to 'Israel' or 'the Jewish people'. The Roman soldiers crucified Jesus and divided His garments into four parts. The form of His garments was gone, and it signifies that the nation of Israel would perish and disappear.

"Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece. They said therefore among themselves, 'Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be,' that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says:

'They divided My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots.'

Therefore the soldiers did these things." (John 19:23-24)

But each piece of His garments remained when each soldier took each part of it. It indicates that the nation would perish but the name 'Israel' would remain. Just as Jesus' garments was divided into four parts, Israel was eventually destroyed in 70 AD and its people were scattered to all corners of the world.

This is why Jews are all over the world to this day. When the city of Jerusalem collapsed by the Roman General Titus, the Roman army destroyed the walls of Jerusalem and set fire to the temple. As many structures of the Temple were

overlaid with gold, gold melted down and smeared into the walls. They tore down the walls completely to scratch gold and not one stone was left upon another.

Pregnant women were ripped open and infants were taken away from their mothers and dashed in pieces. Many were cruelly slaughtered and the remnants were taken captives into Rome or other cities. Israel suffered such a horrible oppression and affliction not by chance but for a spiritual reason.

In Matthew 27 was a scene in which Pilate saw a riot was rising and condemned Jesus to crucifixion, saying, "I am innocent of this Man's blood; see to that yourselves." And all the Jews in attendance said, "His blood shall be on us and on our children!"

Just as they said, their descendants bled so much. When Jerusalem was destroyed by the Roman army in AD 70, approximately 1.1 million Jews were slaughtered. And around 6 million were massacred by Nazi during the Second World War. They made Jesus crucified naked, saying, "His blood shall be on us and on our children!" This was a snare to them, and a terrible affliction came upon them, and they were killed naked at World War II according to their confession.
