On January 1, 2024, I fell down and broke my back. I had to be hospitalized for months and

discharged from the hospital after surgery. The doctor warned me to never lift heavy objects. But I had to move heavy things because I lived alone. Meanwhile I sprinkled my back again and had extreme pain like my back that had been fastened through surgery was cut off.

I went to the hospital again and the doctor said

to me, "You are too old, so there is no chance for recovery. You must just endure." I felt severe pain with even a step like my whole body collapsed. I had great difficulty lying down and getting up, and could neither sit up nor stand up.

I desired to stay with my son when I was about to die, so I was determined to move into the city. After moving there, my sister-in-law guided me to Manmin Central Church on February 23. When I first attended the service, I felt so happy at the joining of hymnal

songs and so much touched at every piece of Pastor Soojin Lee's message.

She prayed for the sick after preaching, and my sister-in-law

told me to receive her prayer with faith and "Amen!" In her prayer, I continually said, "Amen! Amen!" The moment she finished her prayer, I felt cool in my back and I said to myself, "Wow! My back is so cool. No more pain!" I told my sister-in-law that I had no pain in my back at all. On that very day I registered at my church I was healed of the back pain caused by the aftereffects of surgery. Hallelujah!

For the following three months I have felt no pain at all. And I was completely healed of depression by prayer. I have bene healthy in mind and body, so those around me said I had a bright look. 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## I was healed of BPPV in which I felt the globe was moving fast!

On Saturday, March 15, 2025, I went to a spa as usual. After coming back home, something unexpected happened to me. I felt strange and a little dizzy. With the passing of time, it went worse and worse, and I had difficulty keeping my balance.

At first, I considered it as a temporary thing due to fatigue and didn't pay attention to it. The symptoms worsened quickly and I couldn't move properly including sitting up or standing up. It felt like my body was not mine, and I couldn't move my body properly.

Next day, on Sunday, March 16, the things were even worse. Even with a little moving of my head, I felt like the world was whirling around and suffered from severe nausea. I lost my balance and seemed to fall down immediately. It was so much serious that I felt like I was riding on a merry-go-round. I became increasingly dull and scared.

Finally, I called 119 and was sent to the hospital on an ambulance. I received various tests including X-ray, MRI, and blood test, but didn't gain a clear diagnosis. They said I would have to visit the hospital again on the coming Monday because my doctor was absent.

I returned home and was reminded



of the late pastor Jaerock Lee's prayer for the sick recorded on ARS (Automated Response System). I barely played my smartphone and prayed for 30 minutes receiving his prayer from it. I looked back on my past days and tearfully repented of my lukewarm faith since the year of 2006 when I joined in Manmin Central Church. Then, I felt like the late pastor Lee came to me and laid his hand on my head in prayer.

I could manage to attend Sunday morning service via GCN TV. I was so much touched at Pastor Soojin Lee's message and when she prayed for the sick, I received it with a longing for the healing. At that very hour, peace overshadowed my whole body, and wind and wave calmed down in my heart. Dizziness began to subside.

Next morning, to my surprise, I got up in a normal condition. I was able to keep my balance and had a clear head. I was recovered that much enough to go to my work. After that I went to the ENT clinic and got a complete medical checkup. The doctor diagnosed me with BPPV.

The doctor said that BPPV happens when calcium crystals move away and enter semicircular canals that help keep one's balance. And he said that the aggravation of the symptoms may cause them to fall down or to injure their body.

The doctor gave me a medication I had to take for a week. But I didn't take it at all because I was convinced that God had already healed me. God saw my faith and worked for me, so I was completely restored on Tuesday and able to go to my work normally.

When I entered the office that morning my fellow workers were amazed and said, "You were so much sick, but how can you come to the office so healthy?" I glorified God, saying to them, "God healed me!" Hallelujah! I give all thanks and glory to God who healed me.



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The crucifixion was one of the cruelest executions in the Roman Empire. They crucified the condemned nailing through their hands and feet on the wooden cross. When they erected the cross, the criminal had their hands and feet torn apart by their weight and had an excruciating and deadly pain

Jesus was blameless but endured all those sufferings on our behalf to save us. His crucifixion didn't stop at the physical pain, but the mental pain was even greater when those under the cross humiliated and ridiculed Him. He shed all His blood from the cross under the scorching sun, and harmful insects attacked Him who was severely exhausted and dehydrated.

When they said to Him, "You who are going to destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross," He had to endure their insults and ridicules.

But such sufferings were not His greatest pain. He felt even greater pain because many were still ignorant that He had borne all the cruses on their behalf and were going the way of eternal destruction without accepting Him in their stubborn heart.

Jesus opened the door to human salvation by paying the price of all men's sins. His crucifixion was not a mere punishment but the historical hour of the fulfillment of God's plan for human salvation. Jesus bore the

Therefore, through His redemptive blood, we can be forgiven of the sins we have committed with our hands and feet, and we don't have to pay for it on our own.

In Mark 9:45, Jesus said, "If your foot causes you to stumble, cut it off; it is better for you to enter life lame, than, having your two feet, to be cast into hell."

However, Jesus was crucified and paid the price for all our sins and His precious blood washed away our sins that we committed with our hand sand feet. That's why we have no reason to be punished that way. We can be forgiven of our sins and go the way of salvation by His redemptive grace.
