My Wrist Fracture Was Healed Without Surgery

On July 19 this year, I slipped and fell while it was raining. My right hand bent backward, and my wrist hit the stairs hard. When I tried to move my hand, it wouldn't move at all, and I thought, 'What I feared has finally happened.' I remembered how I had neglected my prayer life and spent my time watching dramas instead.

I cried from the pain, yet in my heart came the thought, 'Father God loves me,' and a confession of thanks. Because the pain in my wrist was so severe, I was crying as I held my phone and received Dr. Jaerock Lee's recorded prayer for the sick. After the prayer, I felt the pain begin to subside.

Afterward, I received prayer over the phone from pastor Insook Oh, who advised me to get an examination



at the hospital. Amazingly, after the prayer I felt no pain at all. Even so, I followed the instruction and went for an X-ray. The result showed that my right wrist bone was fractured into three pieces, and one had shifted to the side.

The doctor said, "In cases like this, eight out of ten people need surgery." But I neither had surgery nor took any medication because the pain was already gone. With only a half-leg cast, I returned home and began attending the special Daniel Prayer Meeting with an earnest heart. In every service, I tried to worship God in spirit and truth all the more.

At the 2025 Manmin Summer Retreat, after receiving Pastor Soojin Lee's prayer, strength returned to my wrist and the pain completely disappeared. I was able to move my hand normally right away, and I even went back to work the next day. Hallelujah! I give thanks and glory to Father God who perfectly healed my severe wrist fracture.

I Was Healed of Asthma, Alcohol Addiction, Schizophrenia, Depression, and Panic Disorder

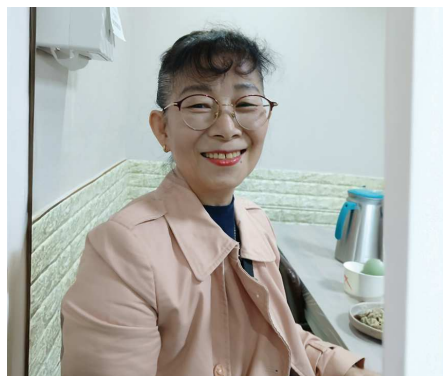

Although I worked as a yoga instructor and lacked nothing materially, there was always emptiness in my heart. Due to deep wounds from family conflict, I suffered from panic disorder, schizophrenia, depression, insomnia, chronic gastric ulcers, and migraines and had to take sedatives. Trying to escape the pain, I turned to alcohol and eventually became addicted, undergoing about eight months of hospital treatment.

While living without hope, I met my husband, Ki-bong Park, about two and a half years ago. With the loving guidance of my younger brother, elder Moon-gyu Kim, and his wife, senior deaconess Young-ja Lee, we moved to Daejeon City this year, and on March 30, I registered at Daejeon Manmin Church.

Because asthma runs in my family, I often struggled to breathe and coughed so much that I sometimes could not eat properly. But on the night I received prayer from pastor Heung-young Park after registering at the church, the coughing stopped and my breathing became comfortable.

Through this, my husband also registered at the church. By the messages and prayers of Dr. Jaerock Lee and pastor Soojin Lee, he experienced God's amazing power as his esophageal cancer, heart disease, hip problems, and other illnesses were healed. However, I still had difficulties in my Christian life. I sometimes skipped Sunday services, drank secretly without my husband



knowing, and even shouted in the middle of the night. The pastors and church members continually visited me, supporting me with God's Word and with love.

The church encouraged me to attend the 2025 Manmin Summer Retreat, but because of panic disorder, I was afraid of being in a large crowd. However, since my brother arranged a private lodging for me, I gathered the courage to attend the retreat for the first time in my life. On August 4, the first day of the retreat, I listened to the message and received pastor Soojin Lee's prayer for the sick. And then I found myself worshipping for several hours among many people. That alone was a miracle. I wanted to go up to the stage and testify, but there was no time. My heart was filled with indescribable joy. My husband, who went up on stage, glorified God by testifying to the healing of many diseases.

Through the summer retreat and the divine healing meeting, my heart—

which had long been unstable due to schizophrenia—also found peace. Before the September Divine Healing Meeting, the church workers and my younger brother took turns fasting and praying for me for two weeks. During that time, all desire for alcohol disappeared.

After receiving pastor Soojin Lee's prayer at the September Divine Healing Meeting, an amazing peace came upon my body and mind. My depression disappeared, so I stopped taking sedatives, and I completely quit drinking. In the past, I was afraid to go outside after sunset and could not attend Wednesday services, but now I go to worship with joy. The church members also rejoiced with me, saying that my face had brightened. These days, I find such joy in reading the Bible, and I've already finished it twice.

On October 12, when the anniversary event of Manmin Central Church was held at Walkerhill Hotel in Seoul, I greeted pastor Soojin Lee with my fellow church members and received her prayer. At that moment, my whole body became hot as I experienced the baptism of the Holy Spirit's fire. I was so happy that I could not sleep that night, and since then, all my diseases have disappeared. Hallelujah!

My husband, who had watched me suffer for so long, now gives thanks each day as he witnesses the healing work God has manifested in me. I give all thanks and glory to our good God who has healed me of many diseases.

Saved From Diabetic Foot Amputation —New Flesh Is Now Growing

Four years ago, I was diagnosed with diabetes, but I lived without taking medication or receiving treatment. Because my work required heavy physical labor, I often couldn't eat on time, and as I neglected the illness, my blood sugar continued to rise.

Then, in early August this year, I suddenly felt severe pain in the little toe of my left foot. The pain made it hard to sleep, and even stepping on my foot was difficult. I had to move on one leg when going to the bathroom. I couldn't go outside without someone supporting me. With an earnest heart, I began a three-day fast and hung onto God.

On August 13, with the help of an acquaintance, I took a taxi urgently to the hospital. After the examination, the doctor said, "Necrosis from diabetes has begun. You must go to a university hospital immediately," adding that the tissue damage was severe and amputation would be necessary. I was transferred right away, and after

another examination, they confirmed that the necrosis was spreading rapidly and that amputation was unavoidable. The surgery was scheduled for August 19.

On Sunday, August 17, two days before the scheduled surgery, I went to receive prayer from pastor Soojin Lee. After reading my prayer request, she examined my overall Christian life and said, "This is not simply a matter of health management. This is something you must thoroughly repent of before God and turn from." She then prayed earnestly with love that I would be healed without amputation.

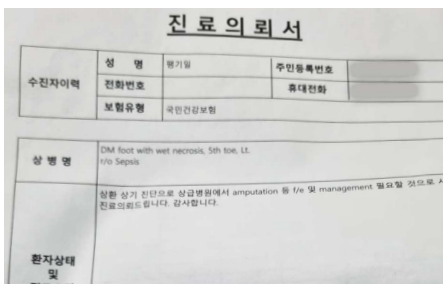
Holding her words in my heart, I looked back on my life. One thing I realized was that, because of financial difficulties, I had stopped giving tithe for about a year. After discovering the cause of the problem, I began faithfully giving tithe again from my recent income. I also repented of failing to share, give, and consider others.

Then something amazing happened. After receiving pastor Soojin Lee's prayer, the severe pain caused by necrosis began to lessen. As the scheduled surgery date approached, I underwent re-examination at the university hospital and prepared for admission, but because the treatment cost was too high, I had to transfer to a specialized foot clinic. There, after another examination, I received the astonishing diagnosis that the necrosis had stopped progressing. An amputation was no longer necessary—



only a small procedure to remove the dead skin on my little toe was needed. The surgery went well, and now new flesh is growing. Hallelujah!

When the doctor said, "If you had undergone amputation, you would need long-term hospitalization," a confession of thanks to Father God naturally flowed from my lips. I give all thanks and glory to our good Father God who had mercy on me and heal me so that my foot didn't have to be amputated.

The Last Seven Words on the Cross 4

Eloi, Eloi, Lama Sabachthani



The words Jesus cried out with a loud voice at the ninth hour—six hours after He was nailed to the cross—“Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani,” are the fourth of the Seven Last Words. The Seven Words that Jesus spoke on the cross to all mankind carry profound spiritual meaning. So, if they were not heard by others, they would serve no purpose.

Knowing this, Jesus shouted the Seven Words with all His strength so that those around Him could hear them clearly and record them accurately. Some misunderstand this verse and argue that because Jesus came to this earth in the flesh, He found the suffering unbearable and cried out to God out of resentment. But this is absolutely not the case.

The Reason Jesus Cried Out, “Eloi, Eloi, Lama Sabachthani”

The reason Jesus came to this earth was to destroy the enemy devil and open the way of salvation for us by bearing the cross. For this, He followed the will of God unto death and completely sacrificed Himself. Having endured every kind of contempt and scorn and having borne all the suffering, how could He have resented God when He knew His death was near?

Therefore, this cry was neither a groan of pain from the crucifixion nor a complaint against God. It carried a clear purpose.

“When the sixth hour came,
darkness fell over the whole
land until the ninth hour.
At the ninth hour Jesus cried
out with a loud voice,
‘Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?’
—which is translated,
‘My God, My God, why have
You forsaken Me?’”

Mark 15:33–34

First, it was to make known that He was nailed to the cross to atone for the sins of all mankind.

He cried out so that all people would understand why He, as God’s only begotten Son, had laid aside all heavenly authority and was being completely forsaken by God. It was a cry declaring that the spotless and blameless Jesus was bearing the cross in such a wretched manner to atone for mankind’s sins and bring them salvation.

However, though Jesus had always referred to God as “My Father,” here He distinctly called Him “My

God.” This is because Jesus was bearing the cross on behalf of sinful creatures, and sinners cannot call God “Father.”

Because He was bearing all the sins of mankind and had been utterly forsaken by God, Jesus could not call Him “Father,” but instead called Him “God.” Likewise, when we truly love God and dwell in His love, we naturally call Him “Abba, Father.” But when we sin or lack faith and grow distant from God, we cannot call Him “Father” but instead call Him “God.”

Second, although Jesus was dying for mankind, many souls would still not understand it and continue running toward death. So, He cried out to warn them once more and awaken them.

God sent His only begotten Son to this earth for us and had Him mocked by His own creatures and nailed to the cross. Jesus fully understood why God had turned His face away, but people who crucified Jesus had no understanding of it at all.

For this reason, Jesus earnestly cried out with a loud voice, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?” so that the ignorant might come to realize God’s love, repent, and turn back to the path of salvation.
